The walls are changing colour.

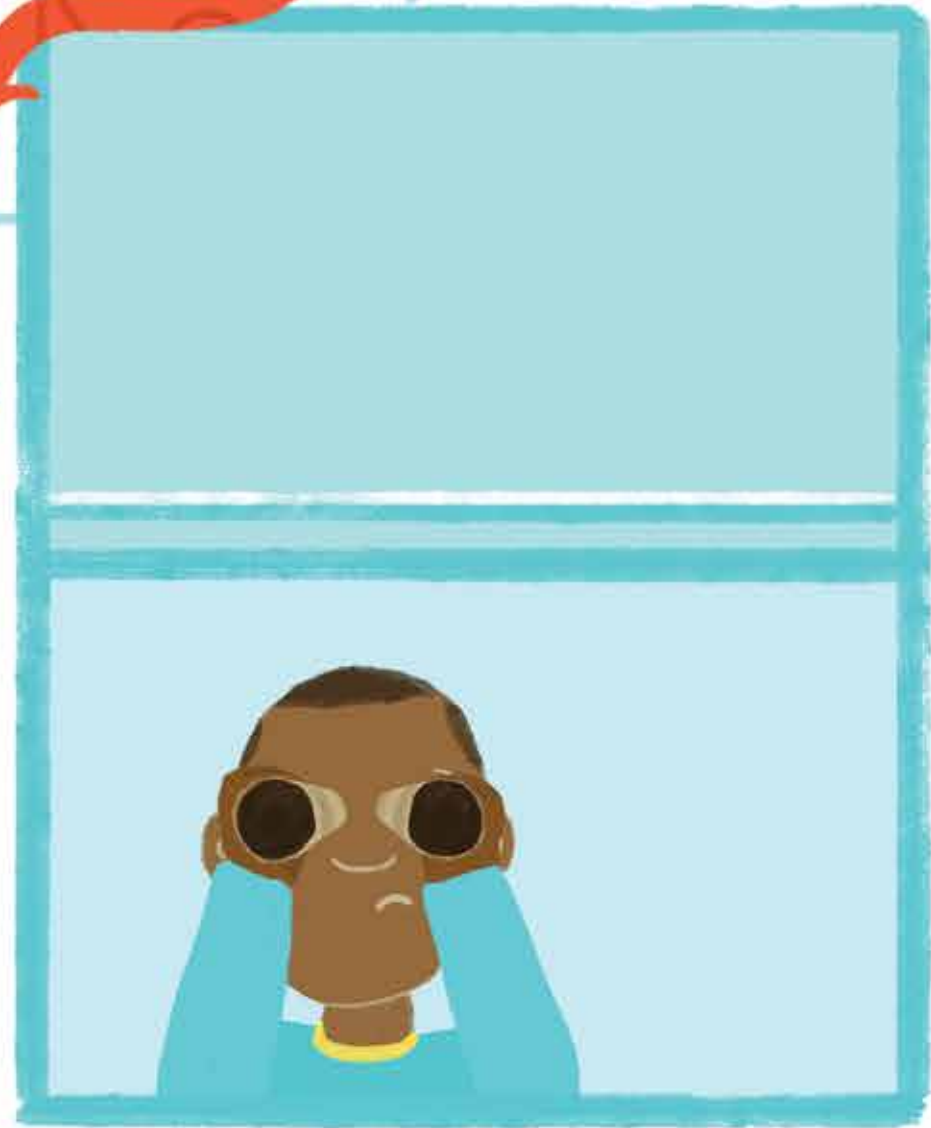
It must be the alien.

It must be the alien.





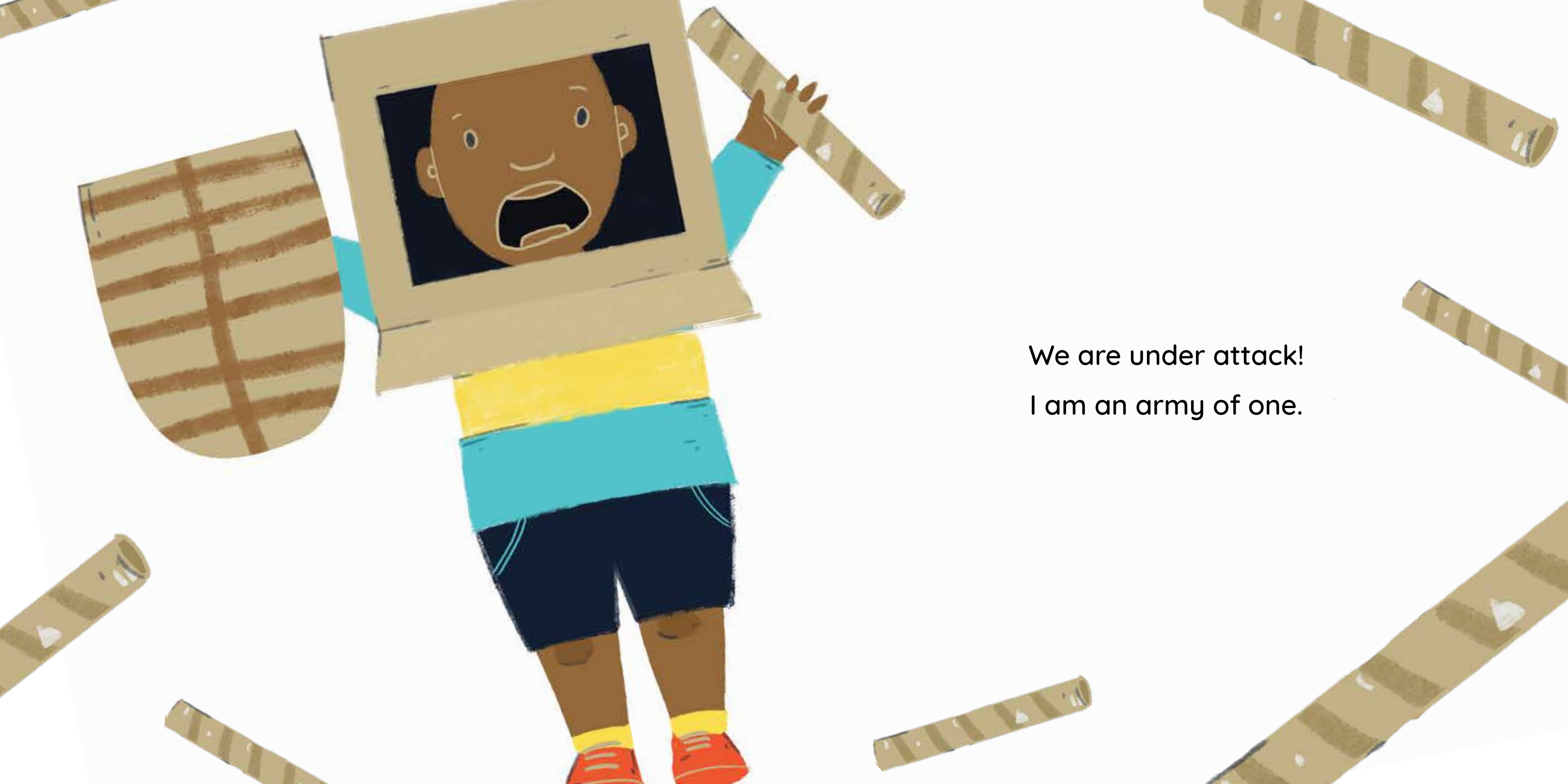
We need protection.

Ready for battle.






5 step, 6 step...

I am by its head.

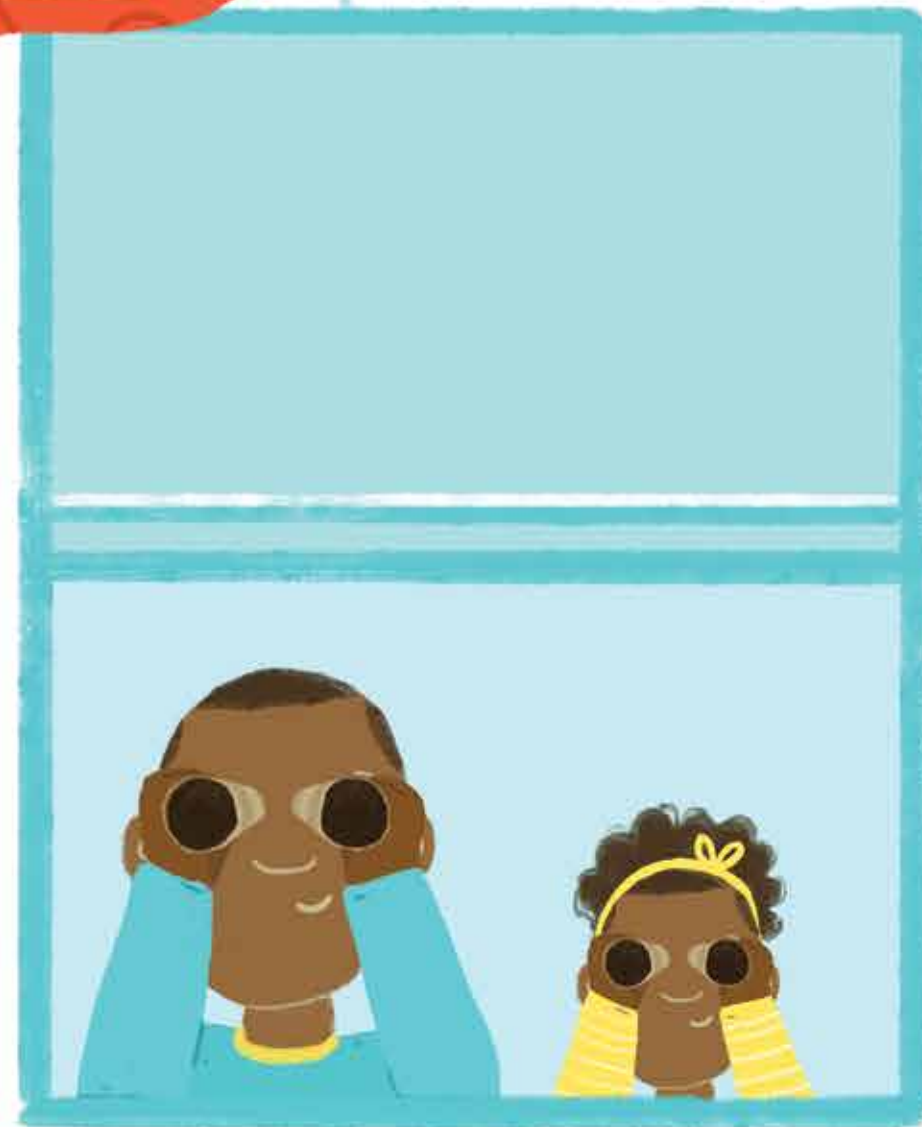
Woah! I get a fright.
