if I want to come to tea.

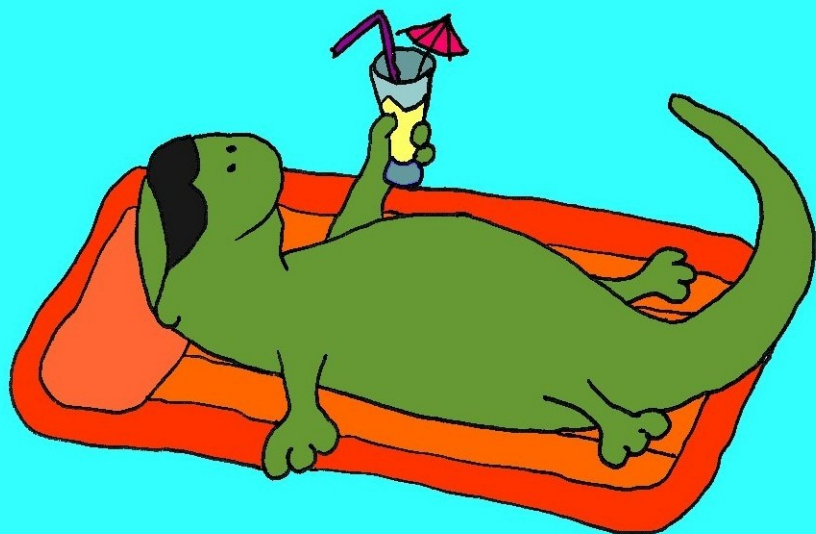
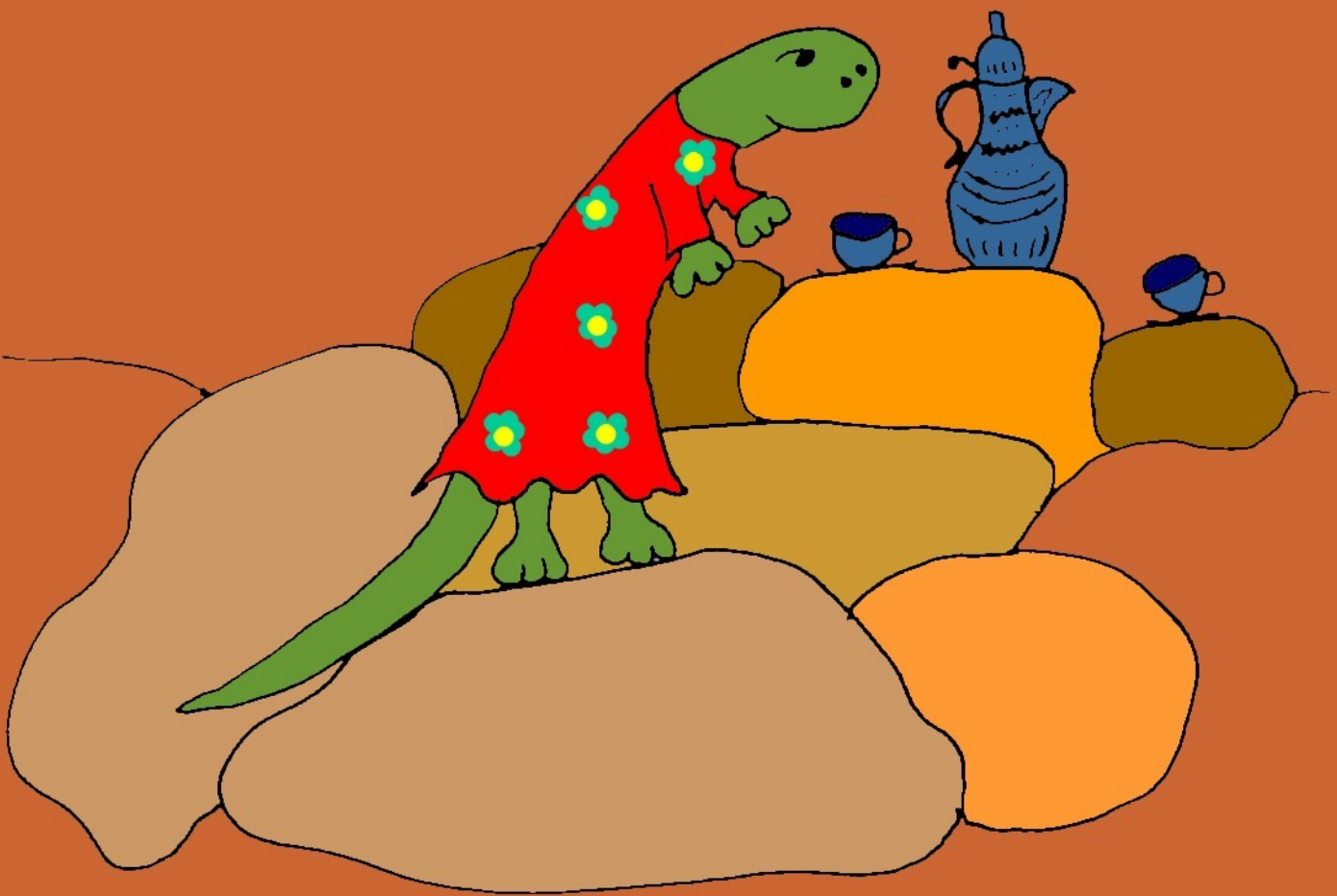

Only on the paper!



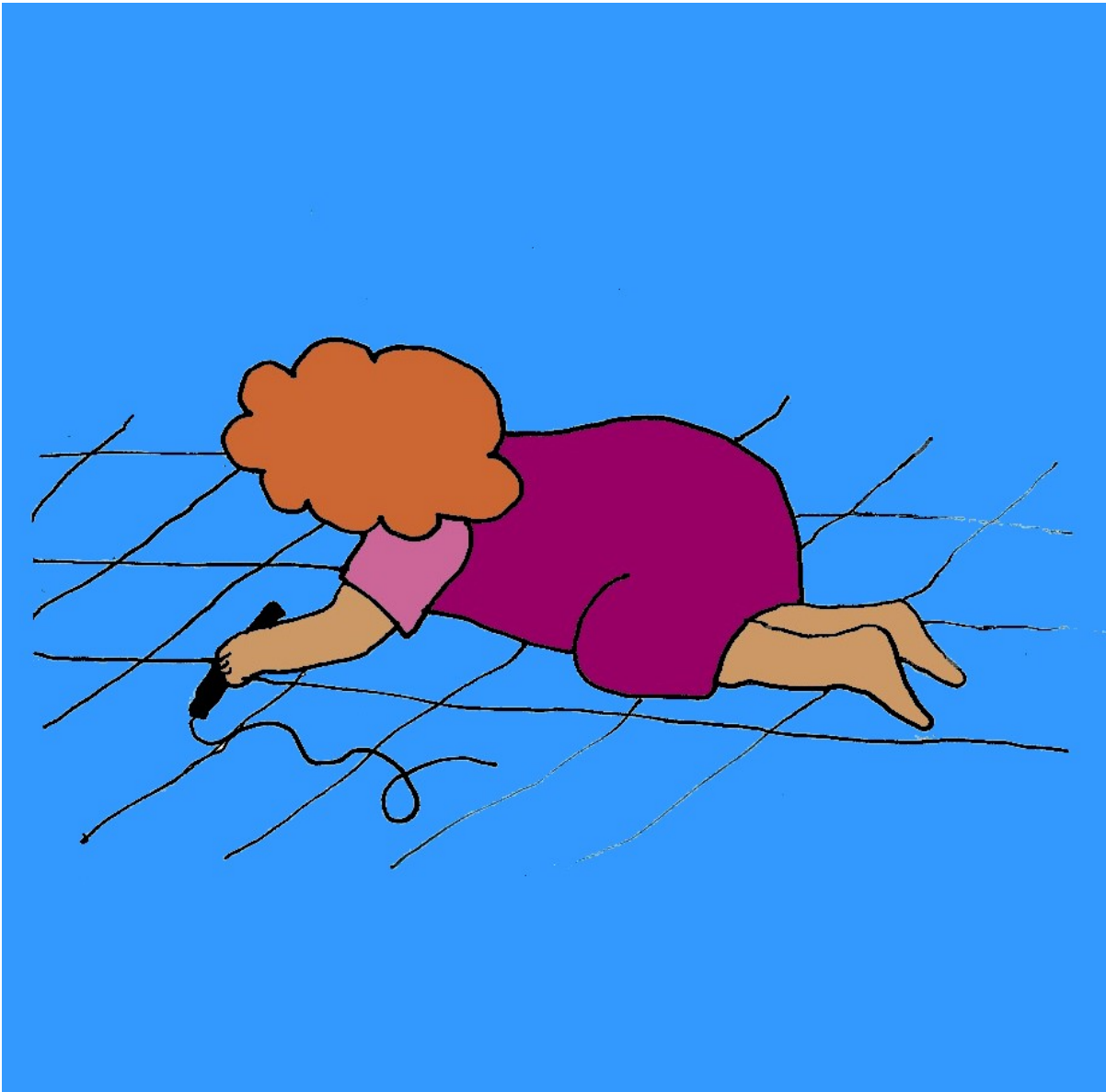
I wanted to write

Only on the paper!



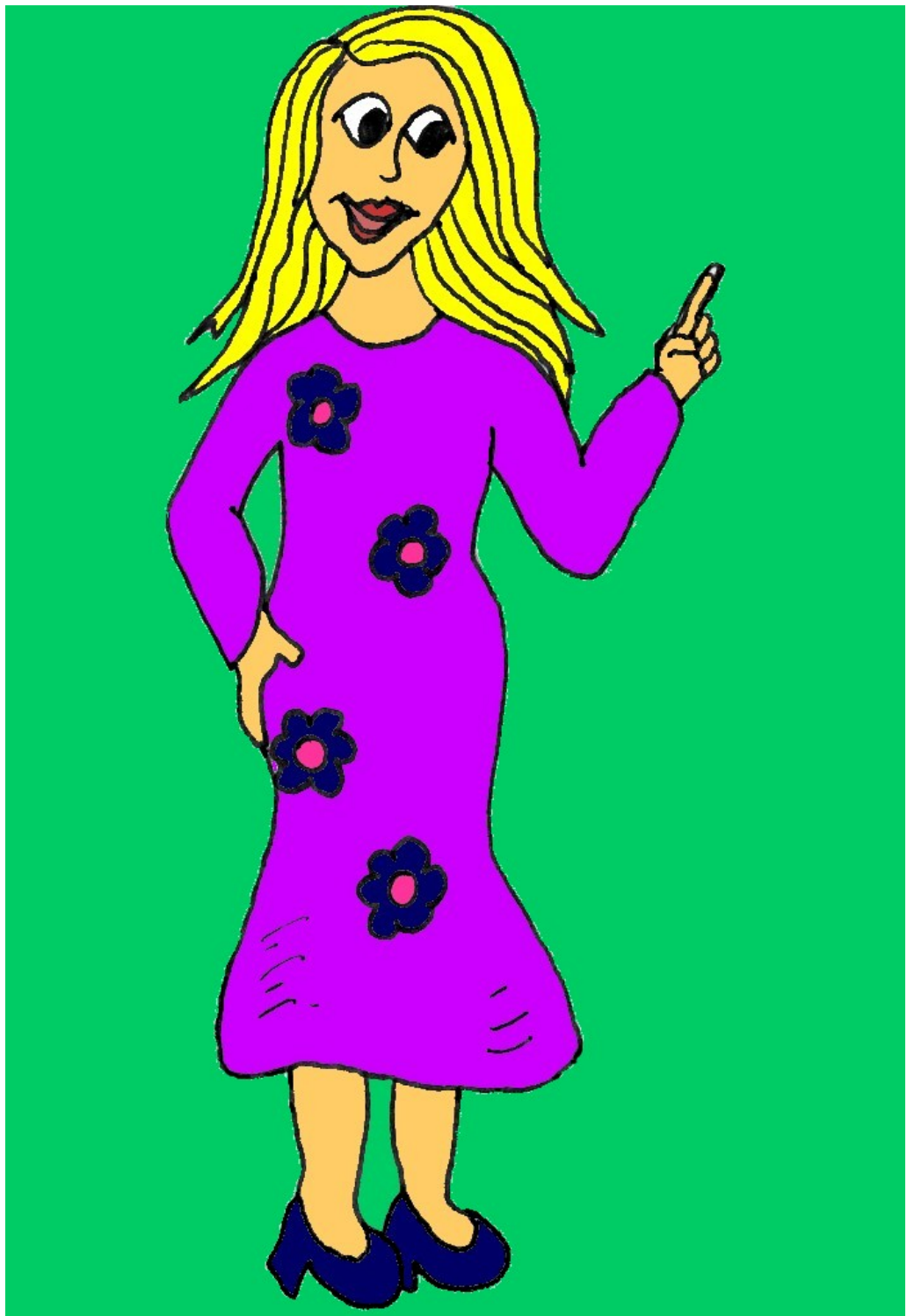

to be bad.

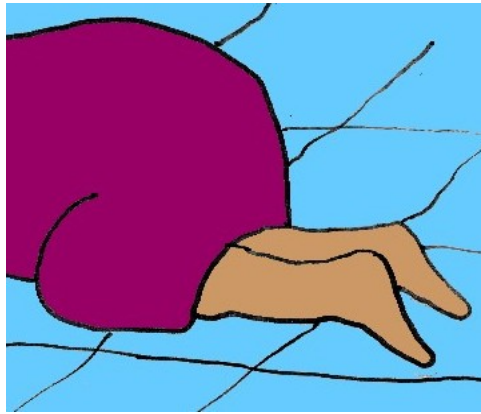

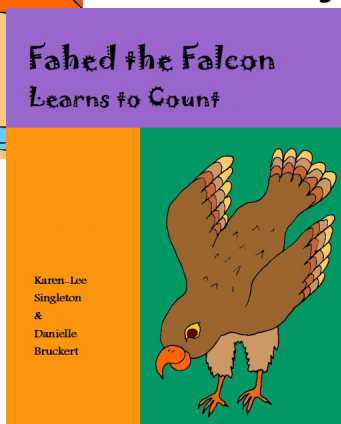


## Arabic Kids Books
