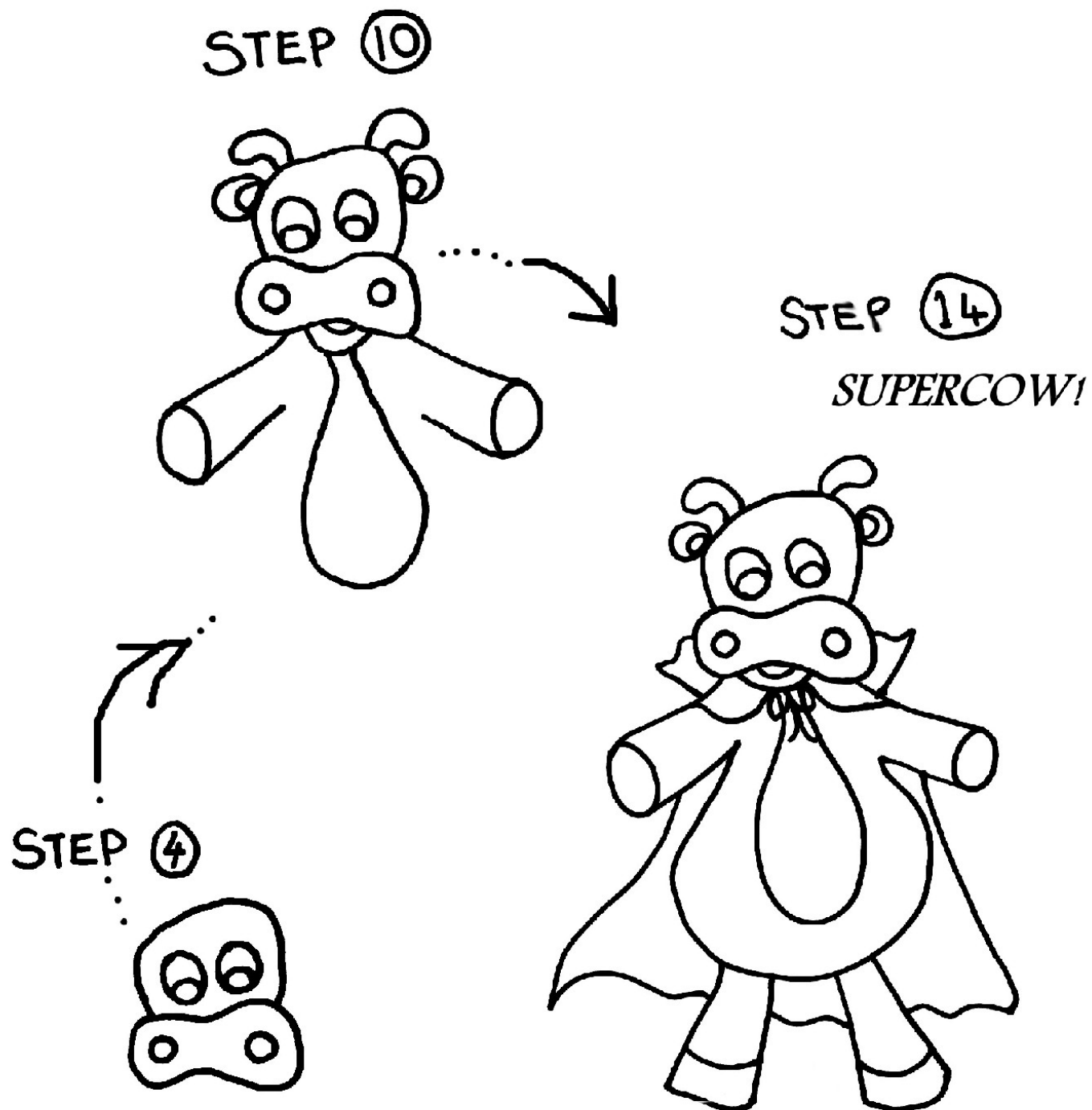

HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

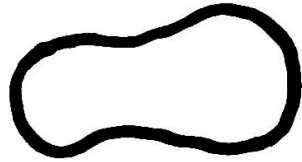

- black felt pen/crayon for your final drawing
- colouring pencils/felts/crayons or paint for colouring in your final drawing

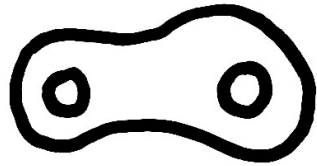

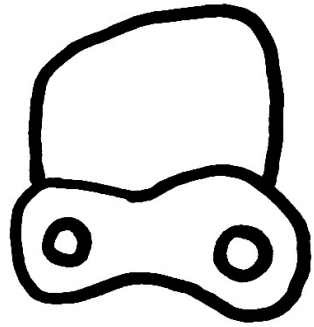
DRAW A PEANUT

FOR COW'S SNOUT



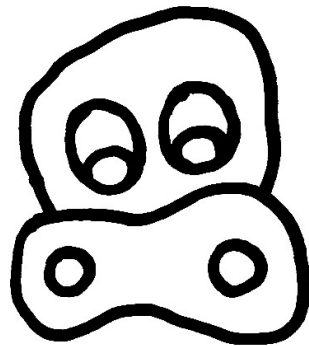
STEP ②

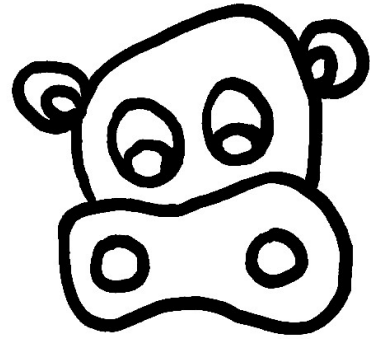
STEP ③

FOR HIS HEAD



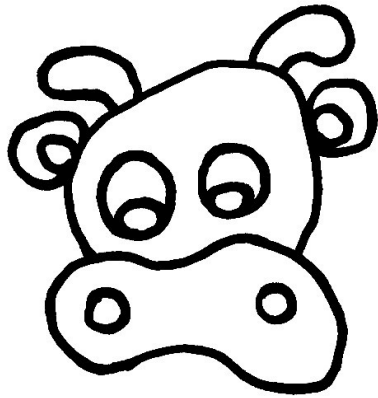
STEP ④

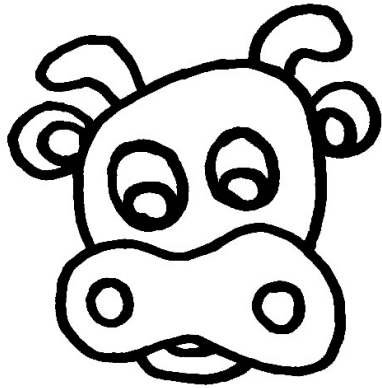
STEP ⑤

FOR HIS HORNS.

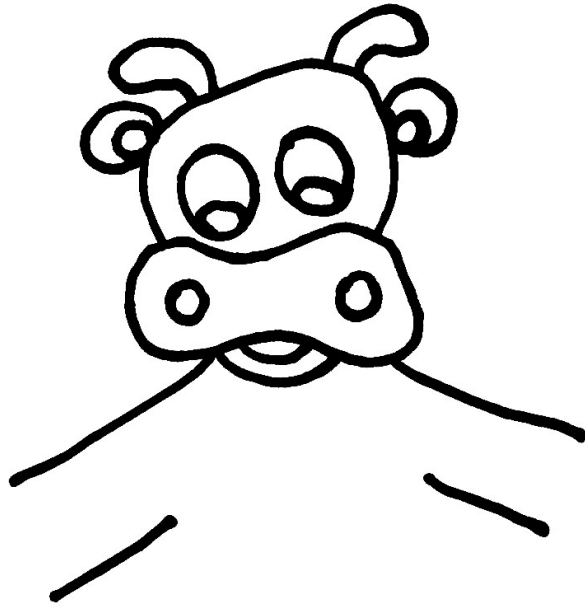


STEP ⑦

FINISHED HIS HEAD!**

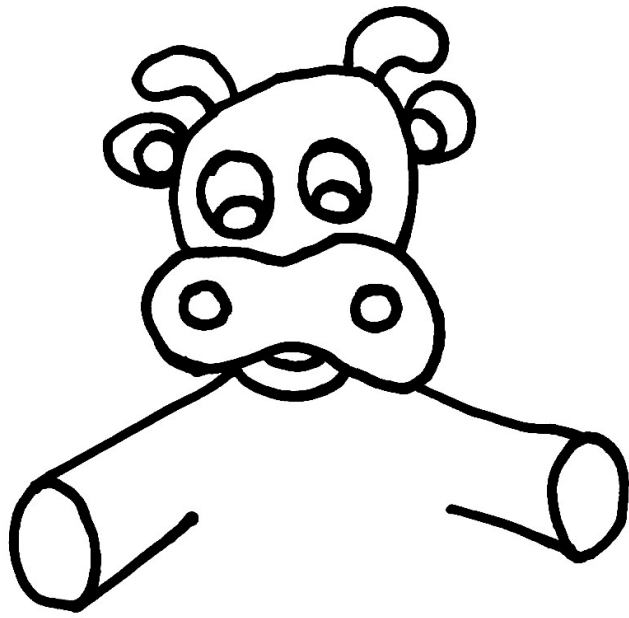

FOR COW'S ARMS

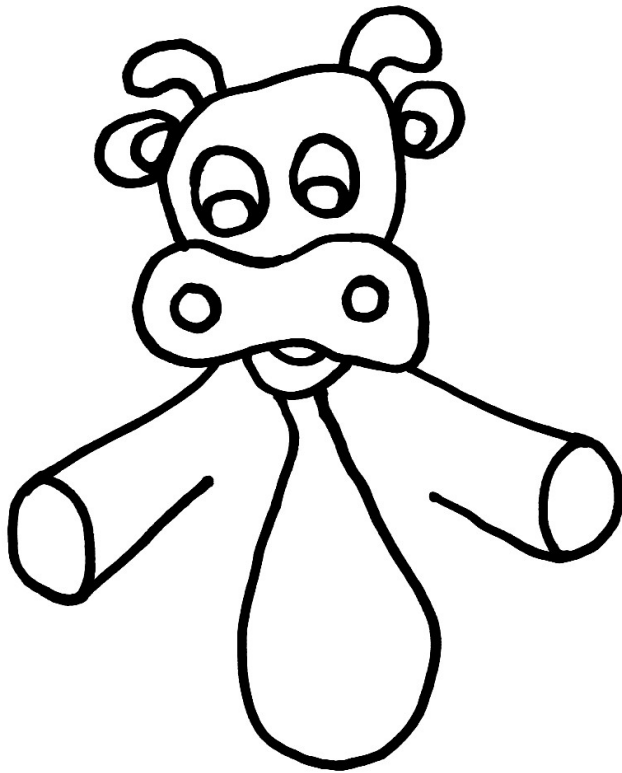

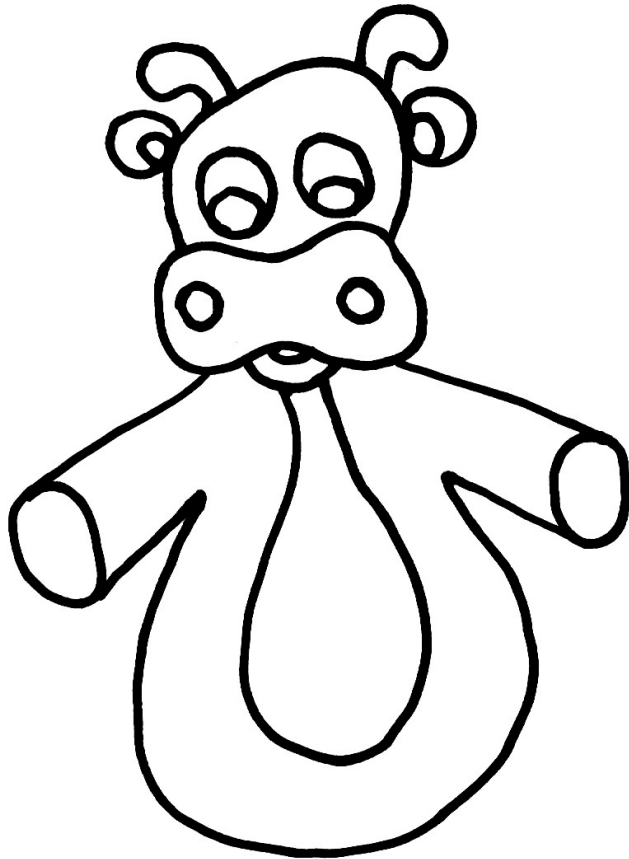
DRAW TWO CIRCLES

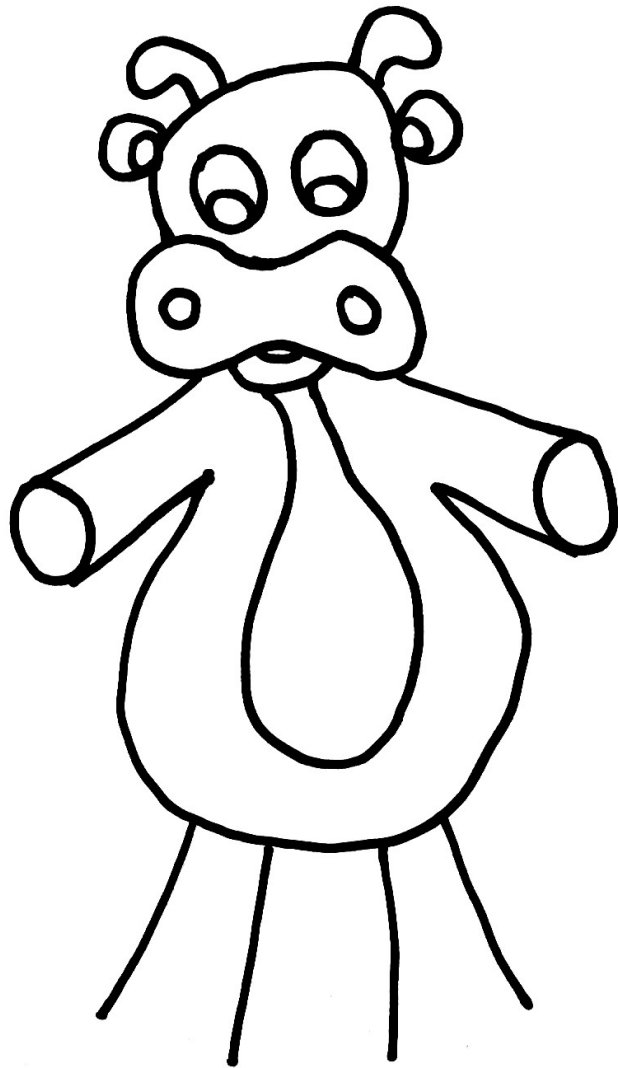
STEP ⑩

FOR COW'S TUMMY



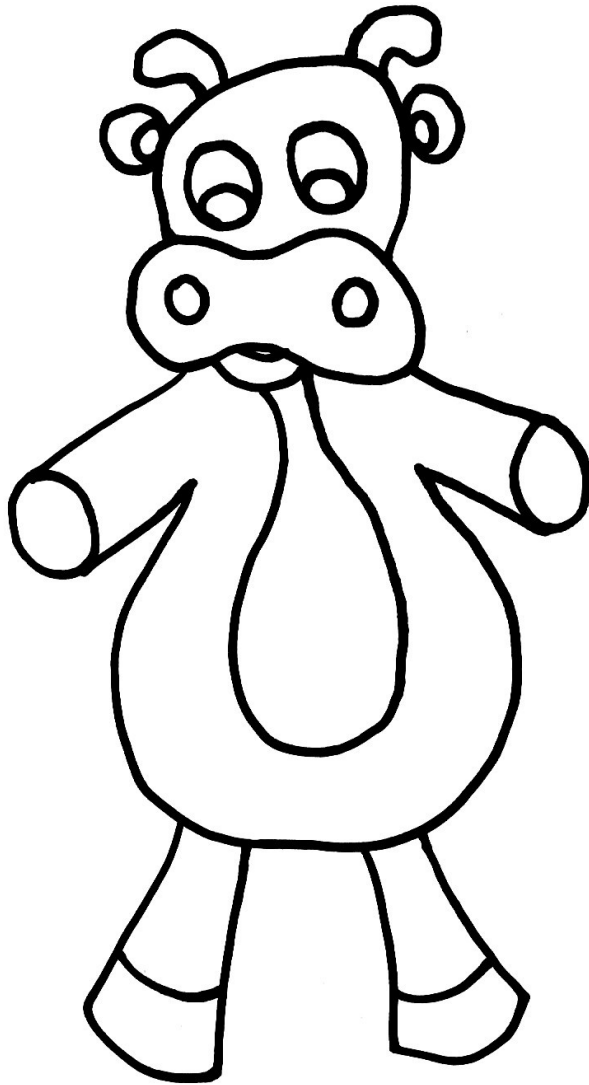
STEP ⑪

LEG TO THE OTHER
FOR COW'S HOOVES.

THE LAST STEP

TO COLOUR SUPERCOW,
WE RECOMMEND:

DARK BROWN - for eyes,
inner ears, nostrils, hooves

LIGHT BROWN - for nose,
tummy, hands

MEDIUM BROWN - for body,
head, mouth, outer ears

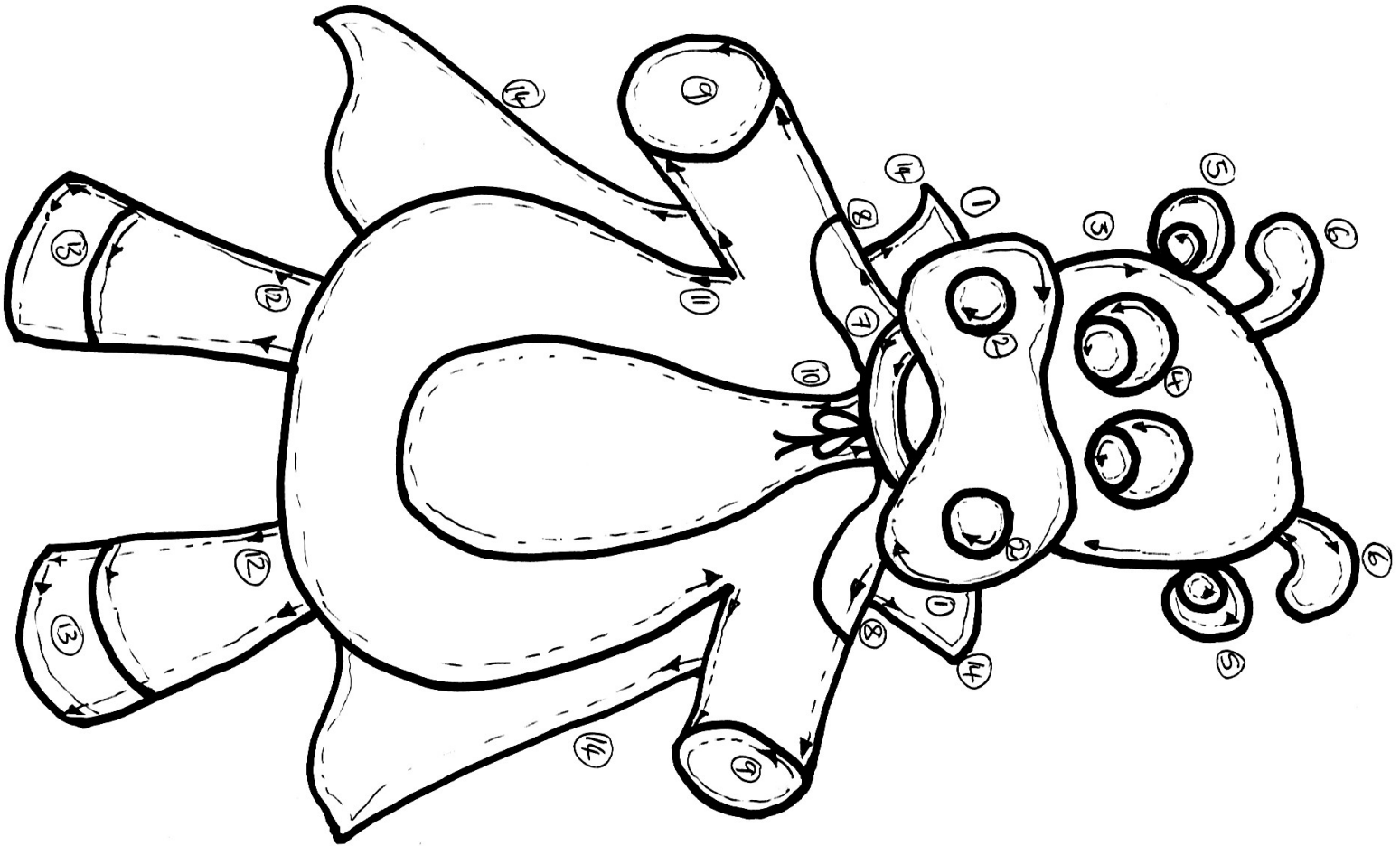
YELLOW - for horns

DARK RED - for inner mouth

RED - for collar

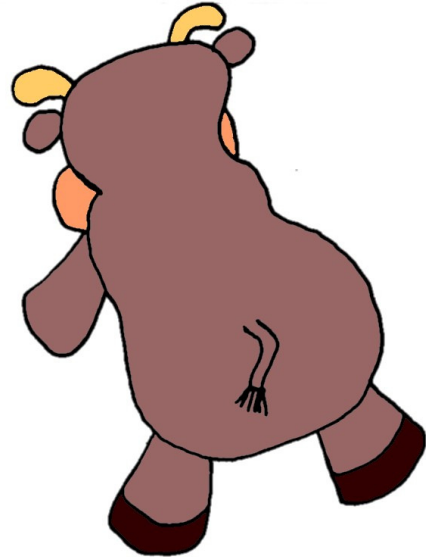
BLUE - for cape
