



But what about when the weather is fine and the sun is ... **HOT**!




Does he still drag around that big bag?



...because love is a gift you can give all year long.








So now that you know some things Santa does in the summer.

Santa in the Summer is primarily a fun book, but there are important learnings that can be gained from reading it as well. You might want to try discussing these questions with your youngsters:


1. What are some of the things Santa loves to do in the summer? What are your favorite things to do in the summer? Which do you like most? Why?

2. What does Santa do in the summer that helps others? What are some things you could do to help others?

3. Santa goes sightseeing to interesting places around the world. Have you heard of any of the places he goes? Ask your parents about them or have someone help you find out about them in books or on the Internet. Also, see where they are on a world map, compared to where you are. In what ways would you travel to get there?

4. The book tells what Santa likes to do when he's not around us. Think of your favorite cartoon characters. What do you think they are like when you don't see them? What do they like to do? Now think of some people you know but don't see all the time? What do you think their lives are like?
