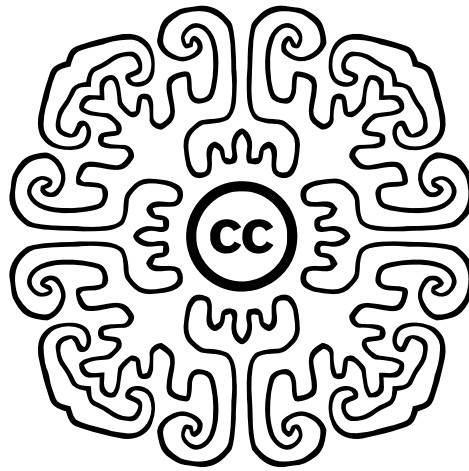

You’re right, of course, but the price you paid on Amazon for ‘Vegepedia’ is the absolute minimum price allowed by the publisher, and only reflects the costs necessary to cover printing (in other words, this book generates no profit for me).

‘Vegepedia’ is released under a Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International (CC BY 4.0) License. This license allows you to share (copy and redistribute Vegepedia in any medium or format) and/or adapt (remix, transform, and build upon Vegepedia artwork for any purpose, even commercial) as long as you give appropriate credit , provide a link to the relevant Creative Commons license, and indicate if changes were made.
