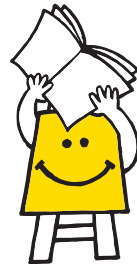

Chandu was flying higher and higher.

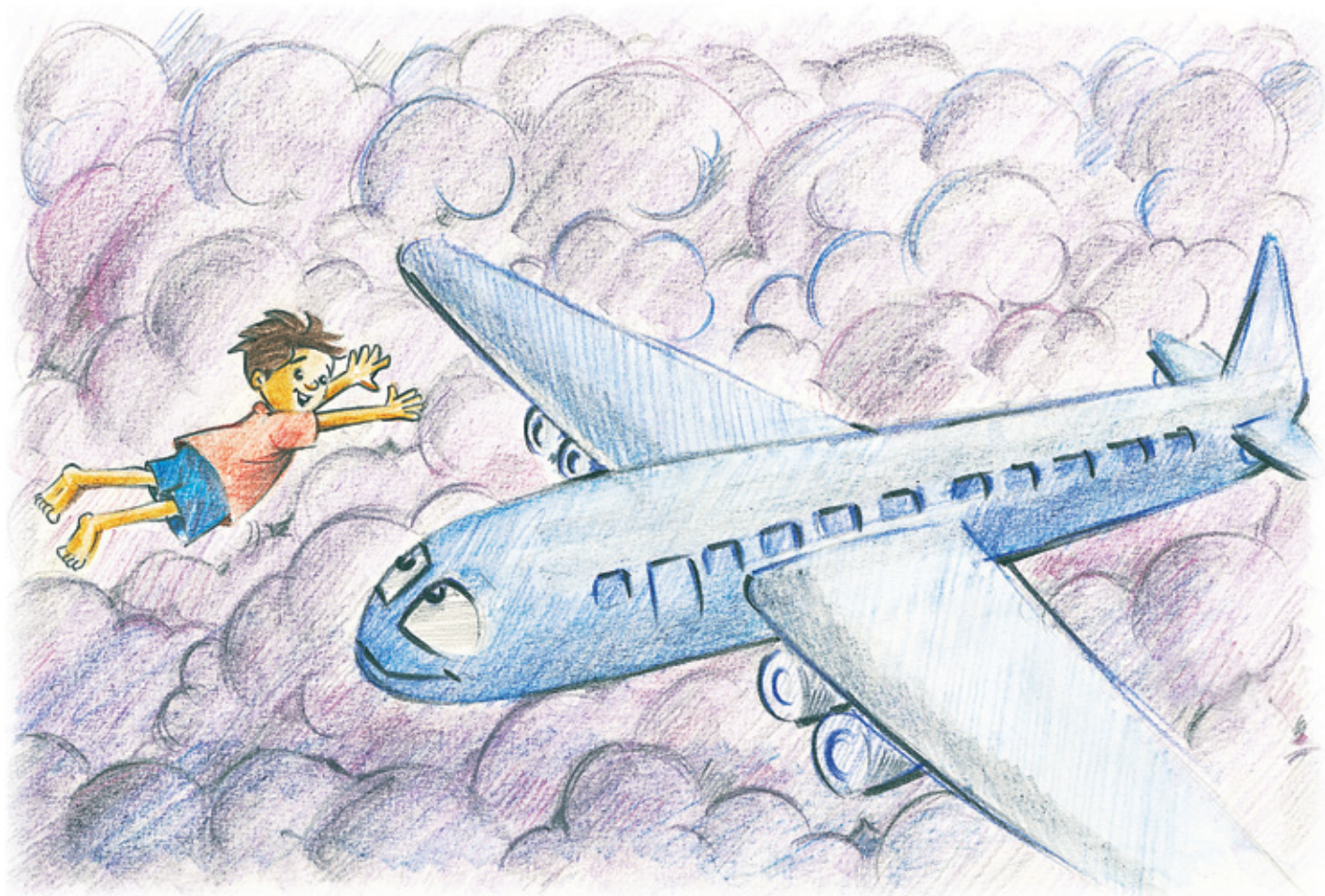
It seemed so easy.

Now the stars were twinkling all around.

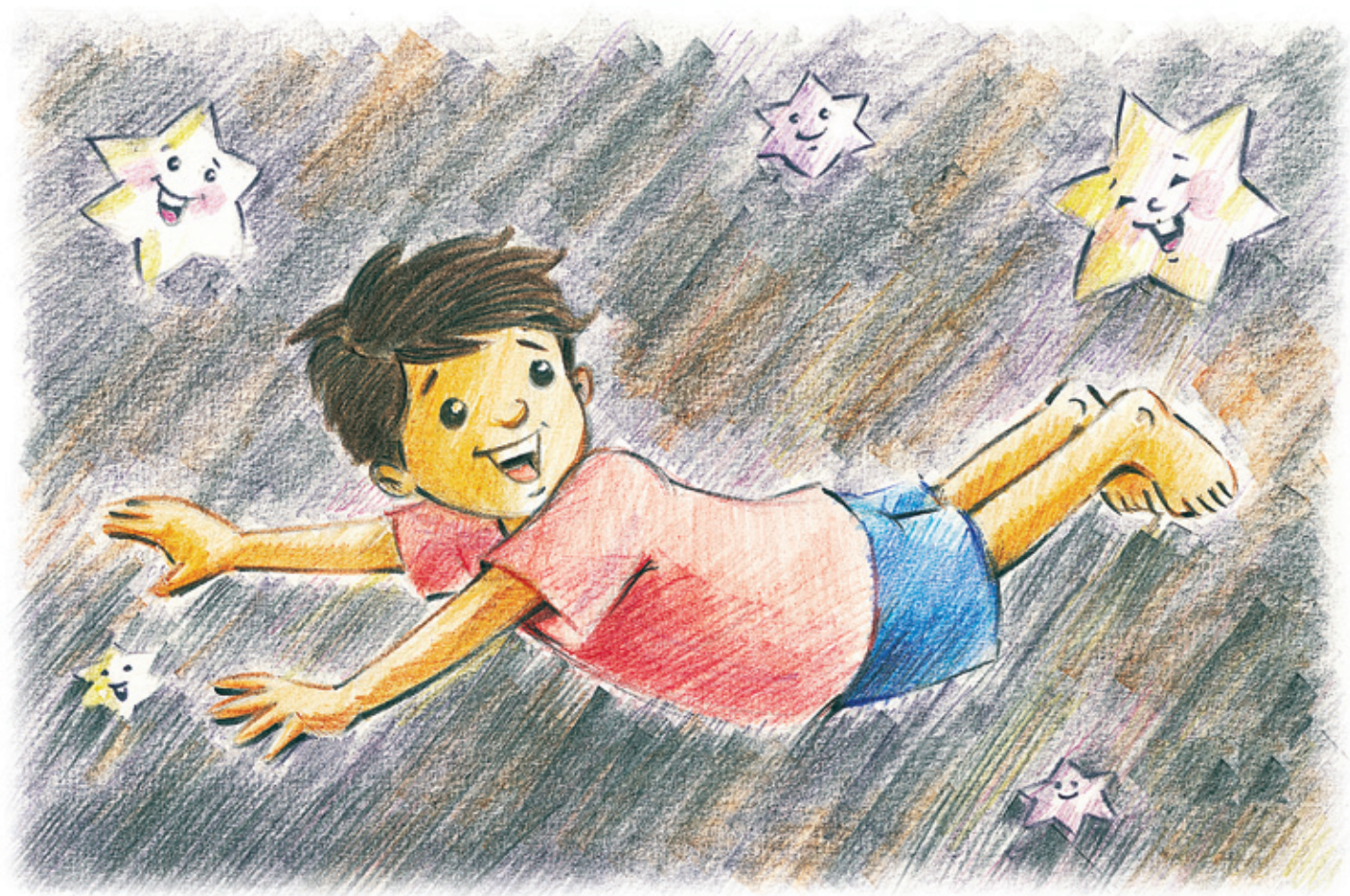
They were smiling at Chandu,
