
This is a **Seahorse.**

It is mostly found in shallow tropical and temperate waters throughout the world.




This is an **Octopus**.

Octopuses inhabit diverse regions of the ocean, including coral reefs and the ocean floor.




This is a **Clown Fish**.

Clown Fish are native to warmer waters and live at the bottom of shallow seas in sheltered reefs or in shallow lagoons.




These are **Dolphins**.
