“Can I **help?**” asked Sam. “I could **stir.**”

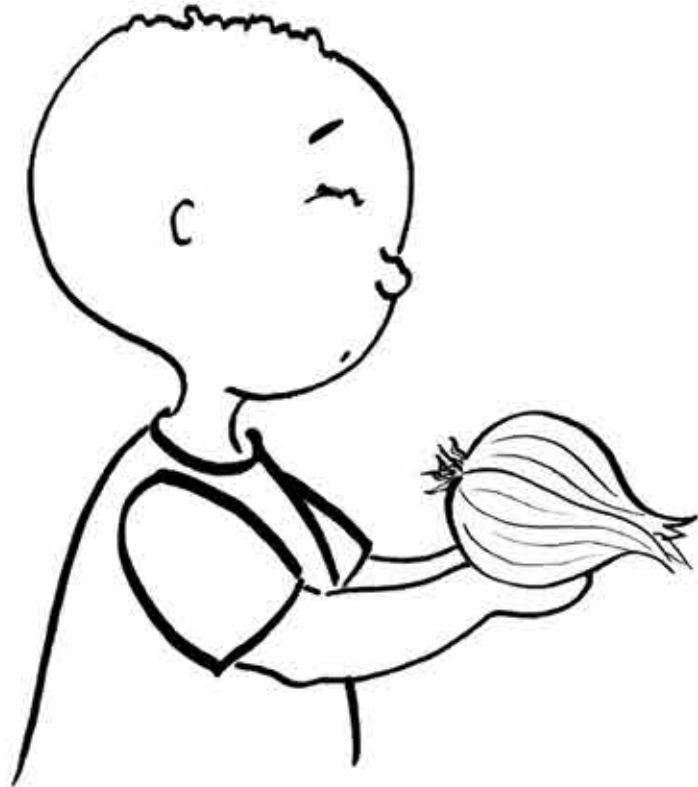
“You are still a bit **short,**”

by **fetching** things.”

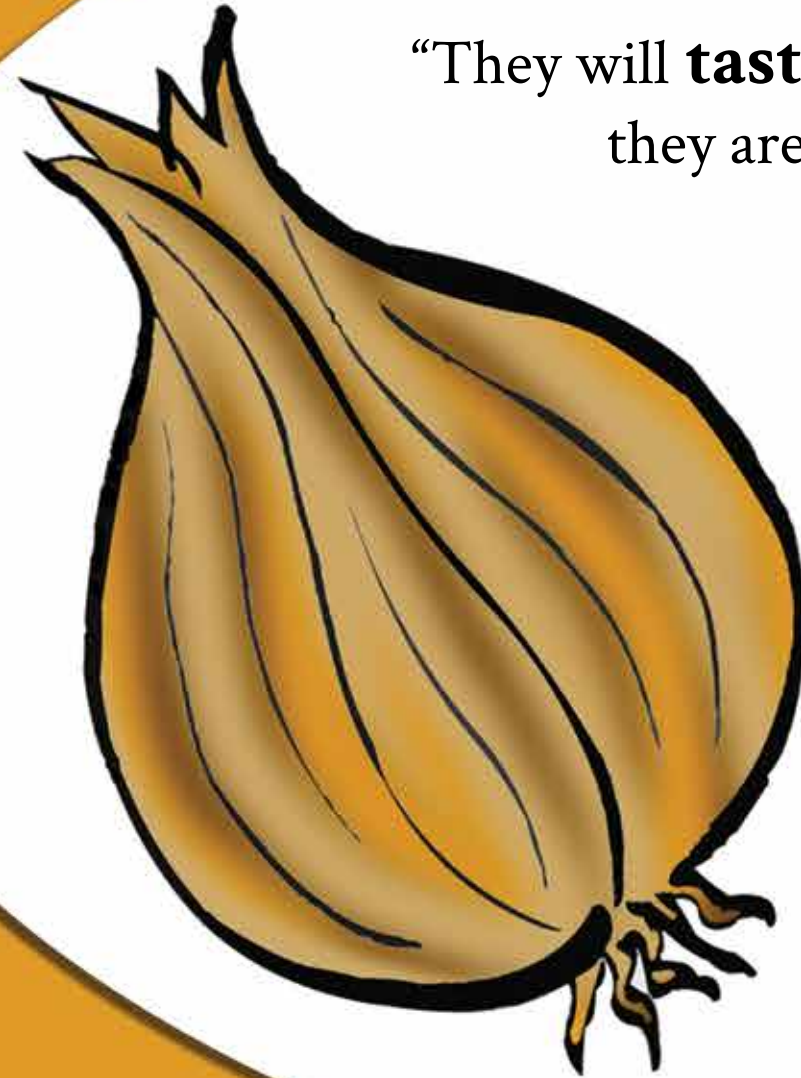


“Can you bring me an **onion**, please.”

“This doesn’t **smell** very nice.”



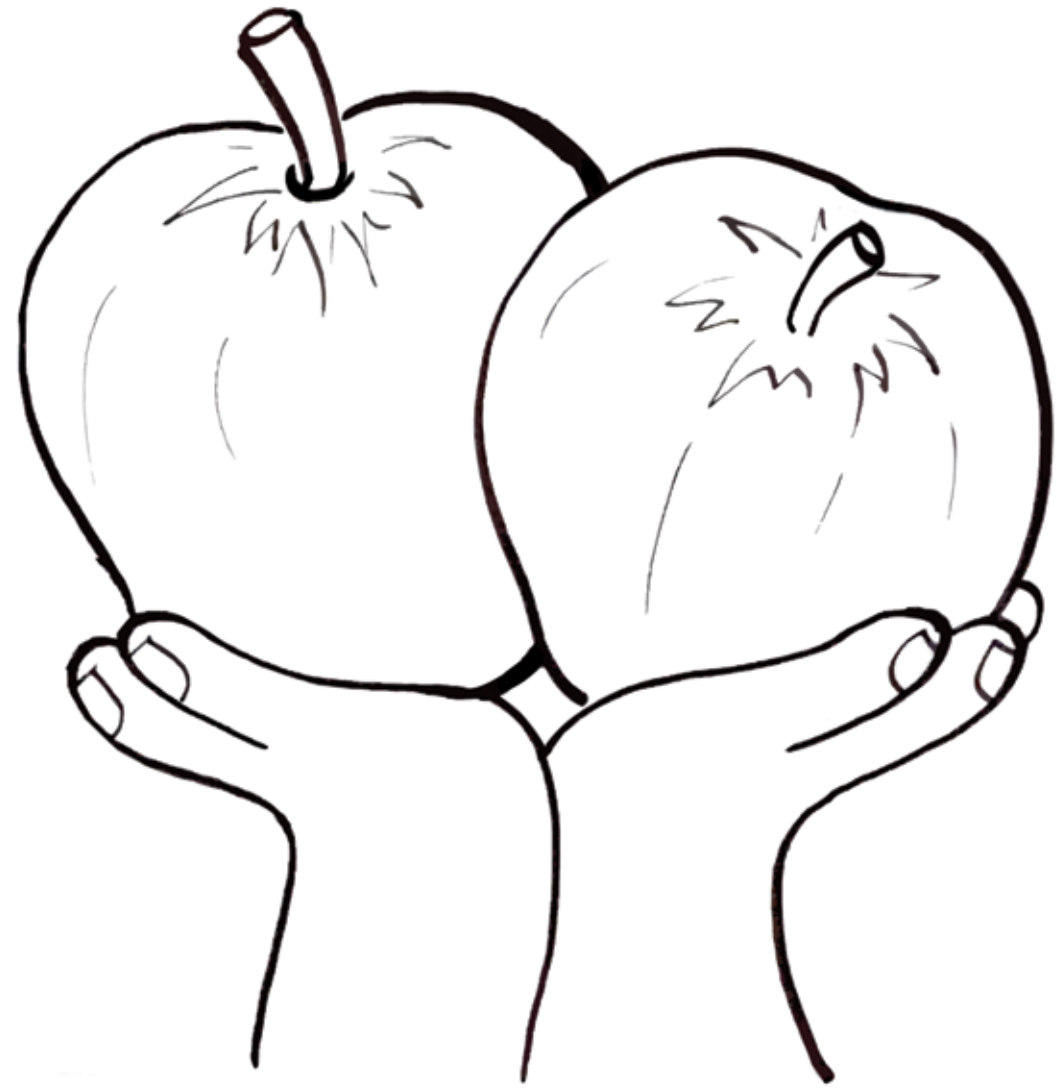
“They will **taste** nice once they are **cooked**.”

but you will find them in the fridge.”

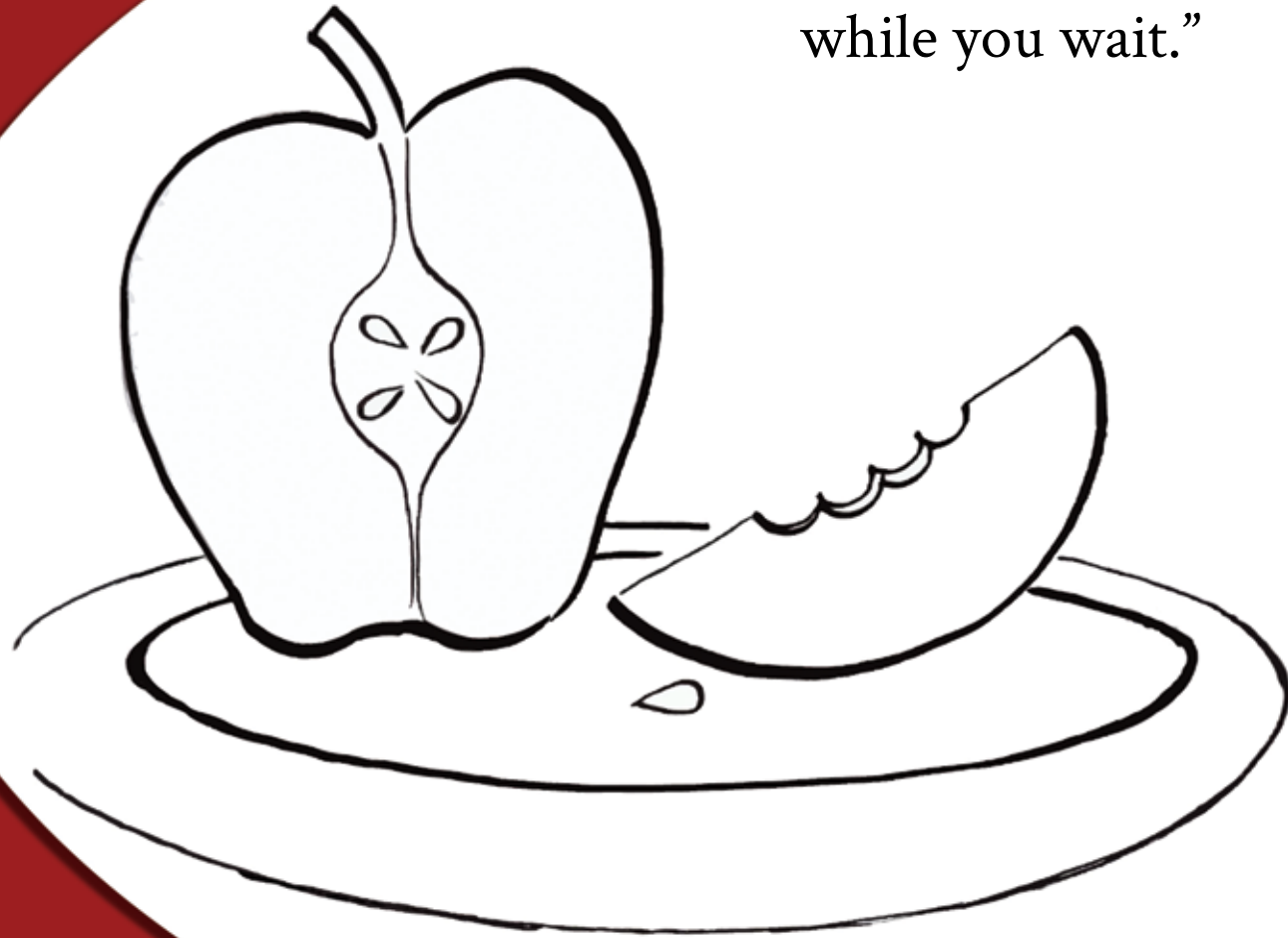


“Can you bring me **potatoes**.

“It’s a **surprise**. Wait and see.”

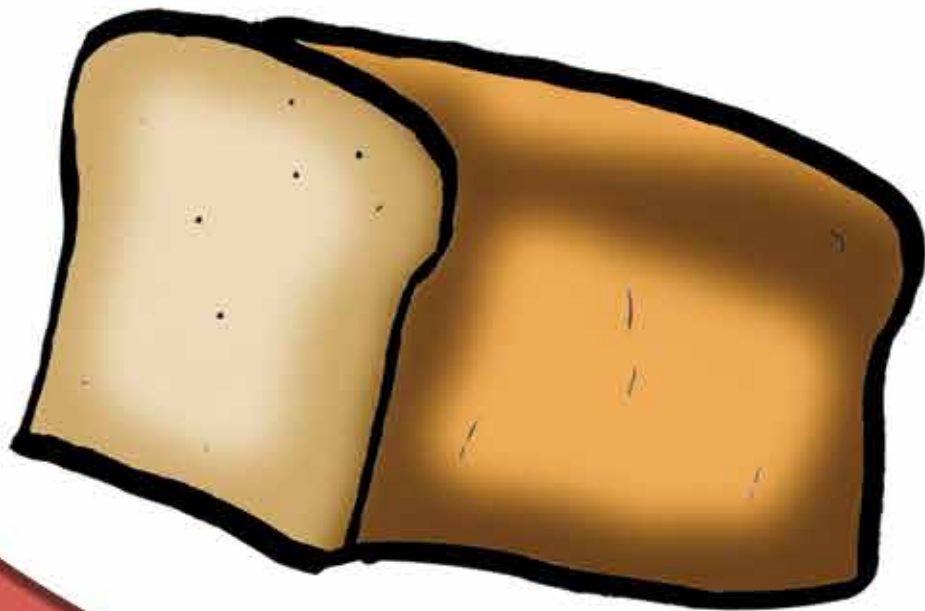
“What about **this?**”

“That is a **watermelon**. It will be too big for the pot.”

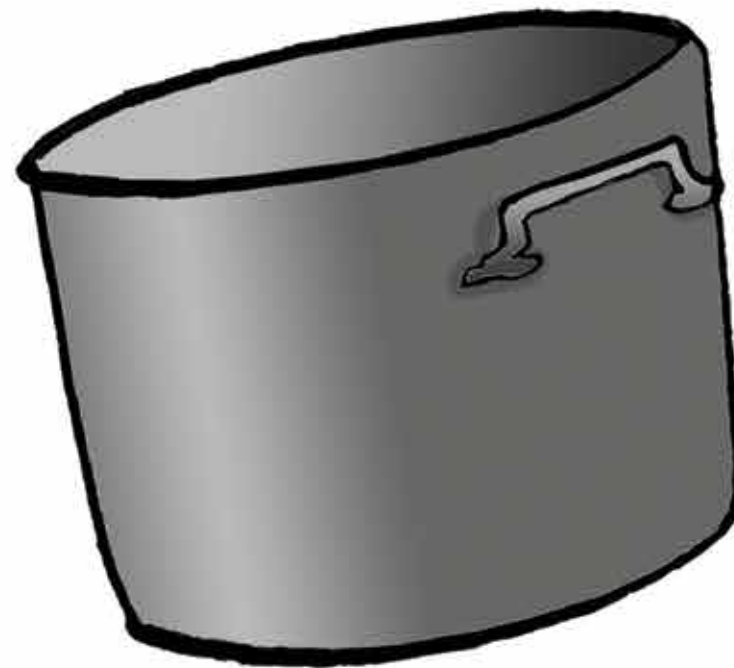


“See if you can find some **spinach**.
