




Animals live all around us.




Birds build their homes up high.

And so do bees.




Spiders spin
their homes.




Tiny termites build

Snails and tortoises grow homes on their backs.




Fish live in the water.

Frogs can live in water and on land.






Rabbits and rats live in burrows under the ground.




Monkeys and apes make trees their homes.



Bears and wolves live in dens.




Crocodiles live in swamps.
