Who loves resting in burrows?

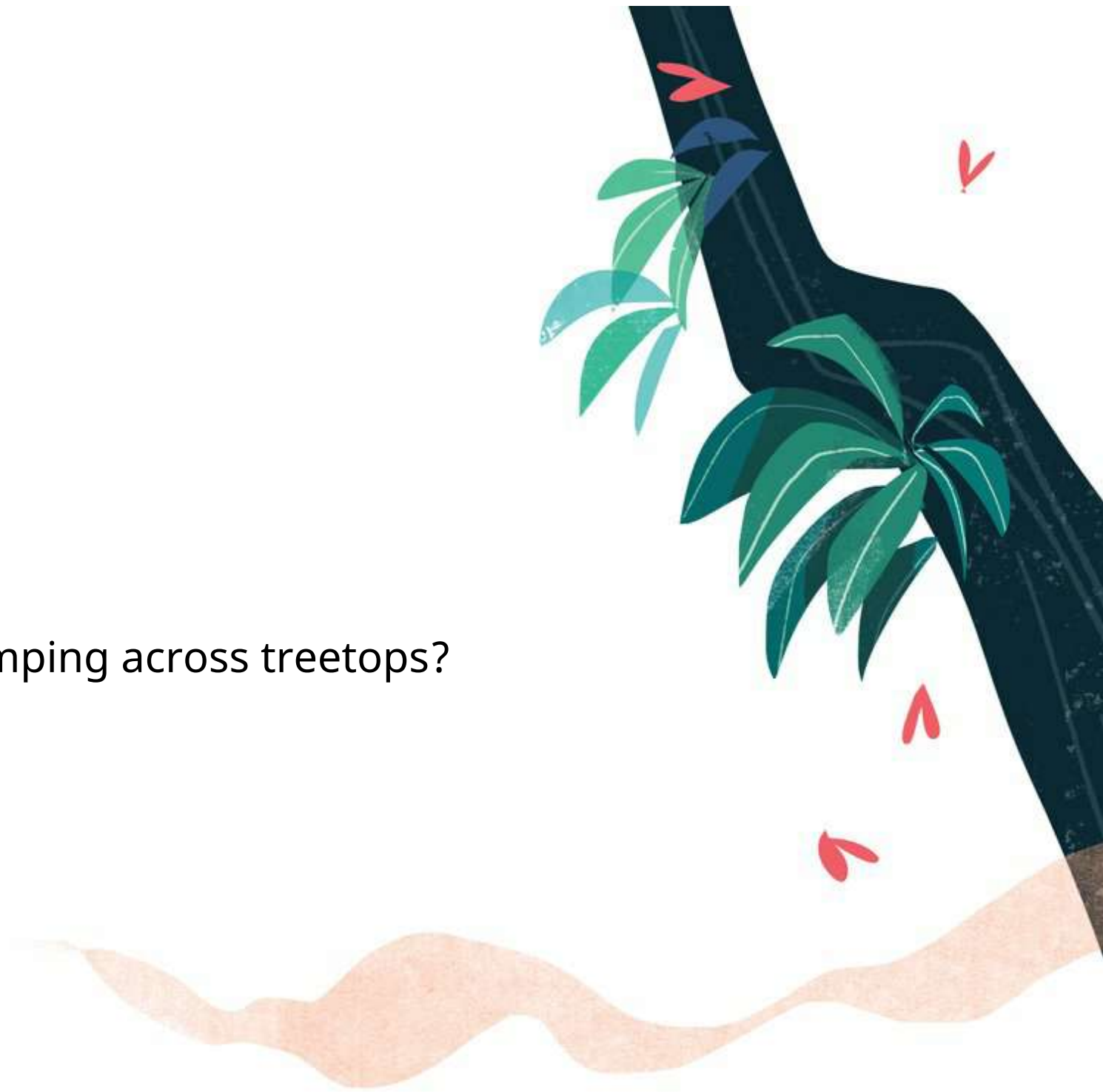




The Thick-tailed Pangolin

Who loves jumping across treetops?







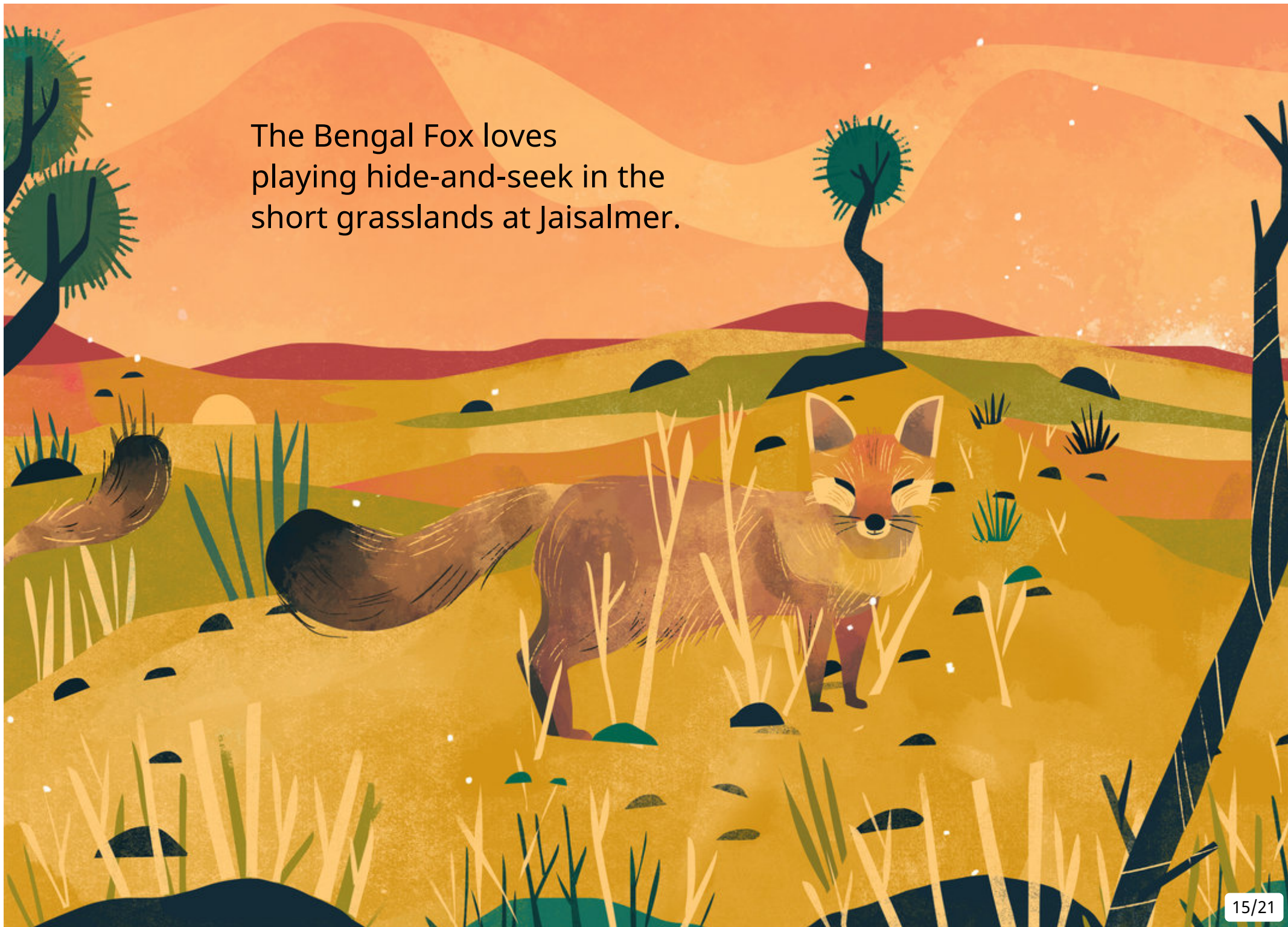
The Yellow-throated Marten loves jumping across treetops in Namdapha.
