Después Chandu se elevó un poco más. Volando, todavía volando, se encontró un águila.


[&]quot;¡Hola amigo! ¿Cómo estás?" el águila preguntó.

"Muy bien" Sonrió Chandu.




Chandu voló todavía más alto.
