Falling from the sky.



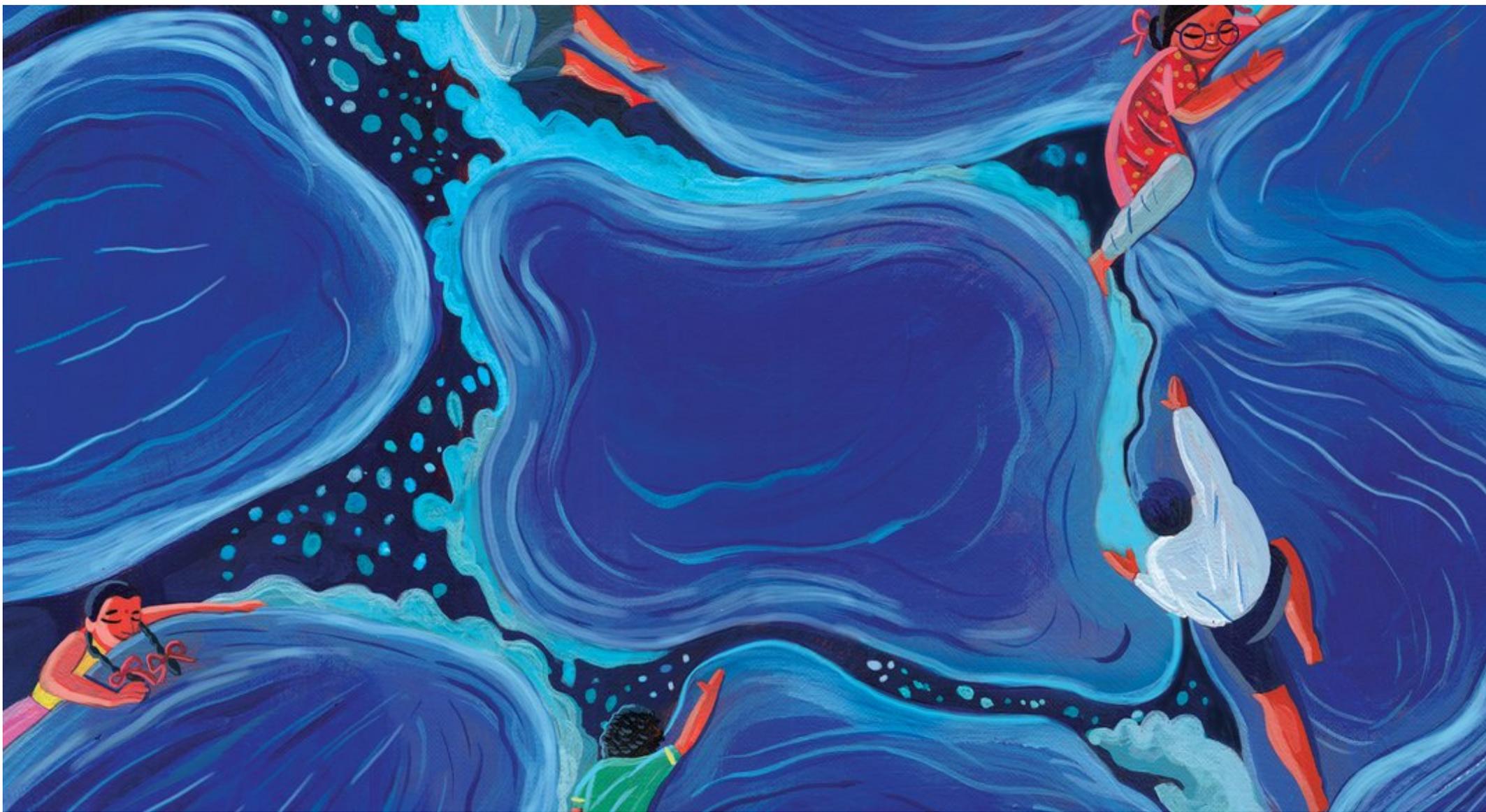
Rain hits the ground,

Squeeze into cracks,

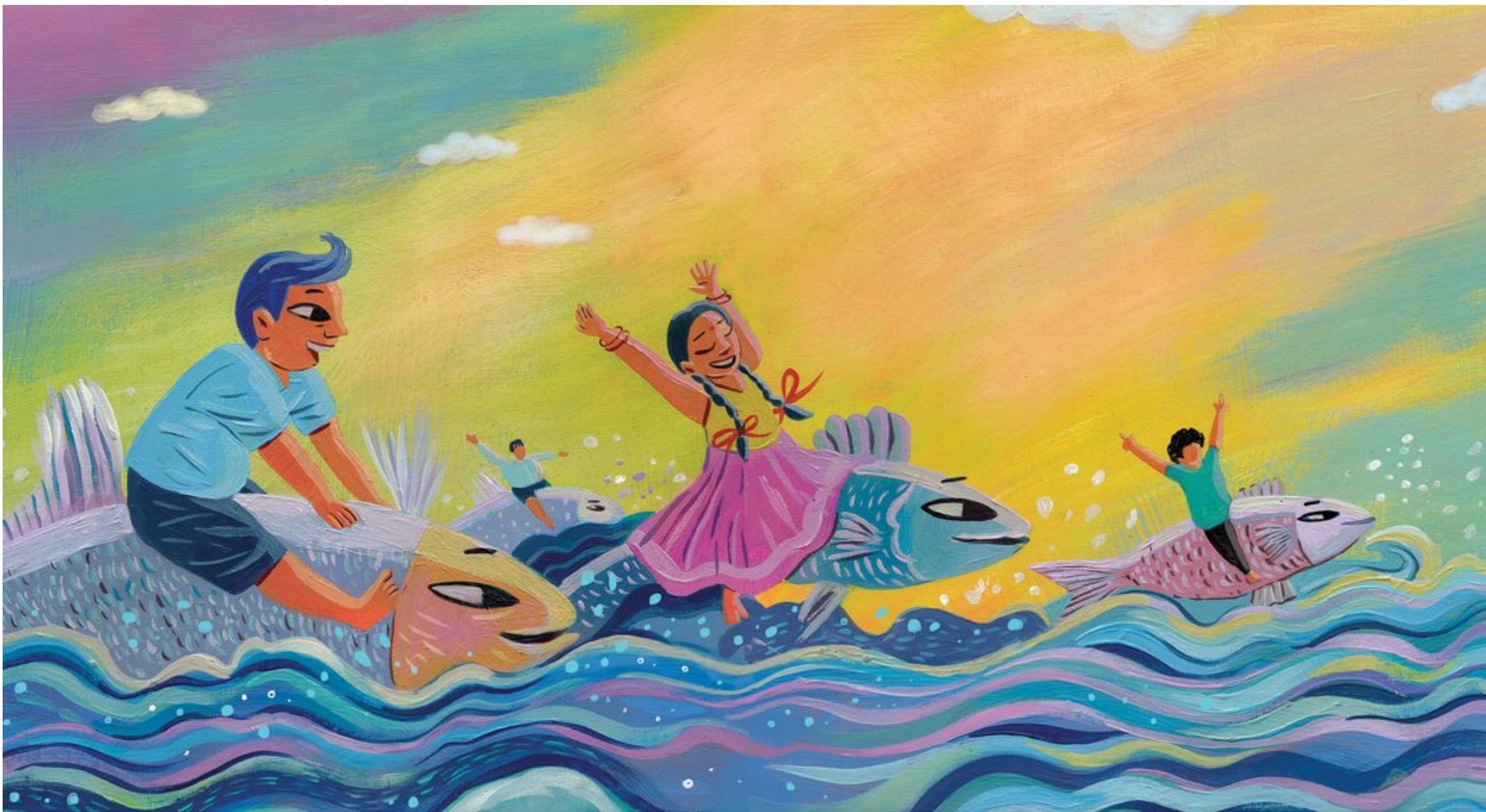


Moisture moves, out of sight,
Deep underground.

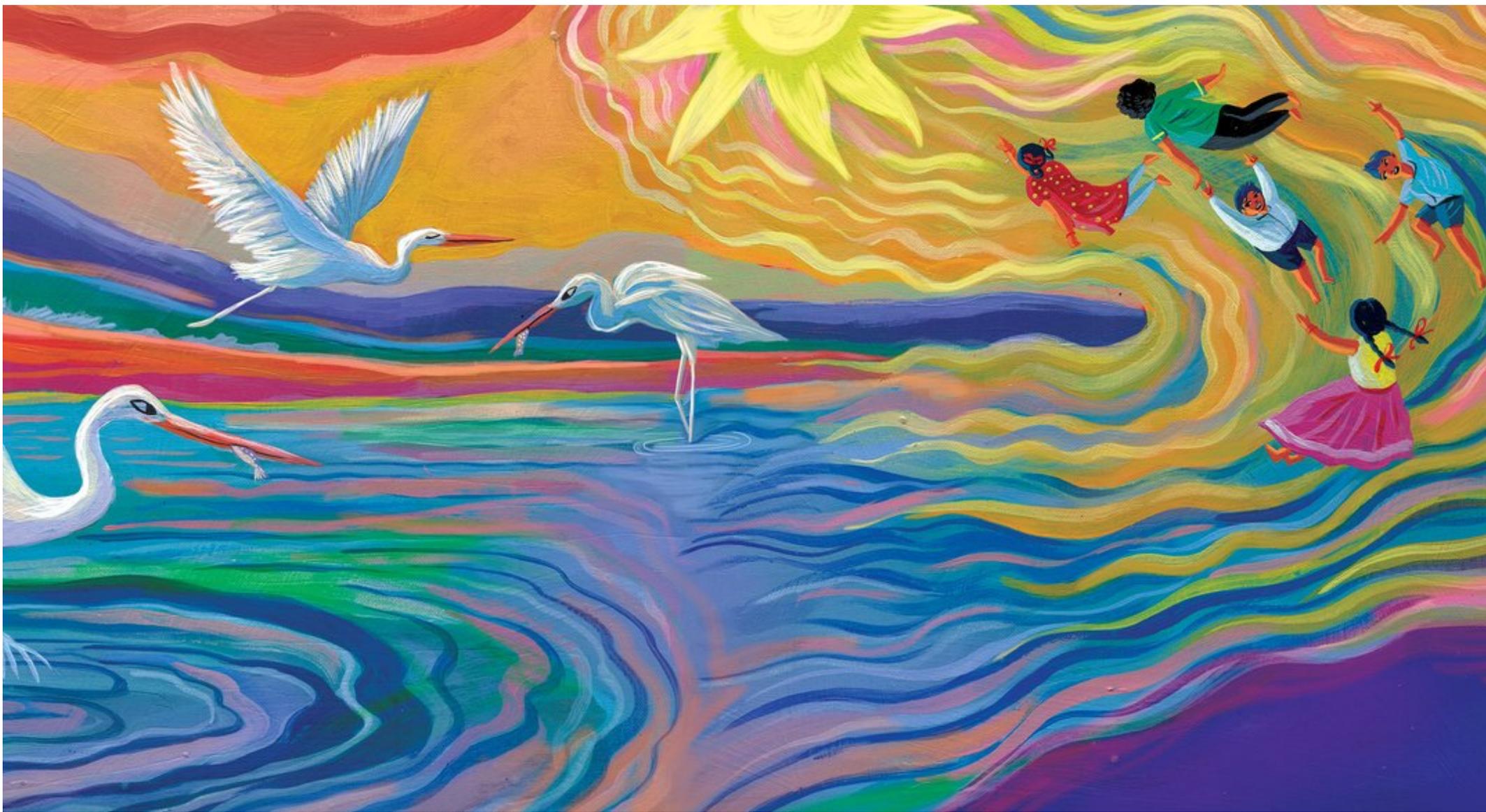




Spring from the earth,

Up the water floats,



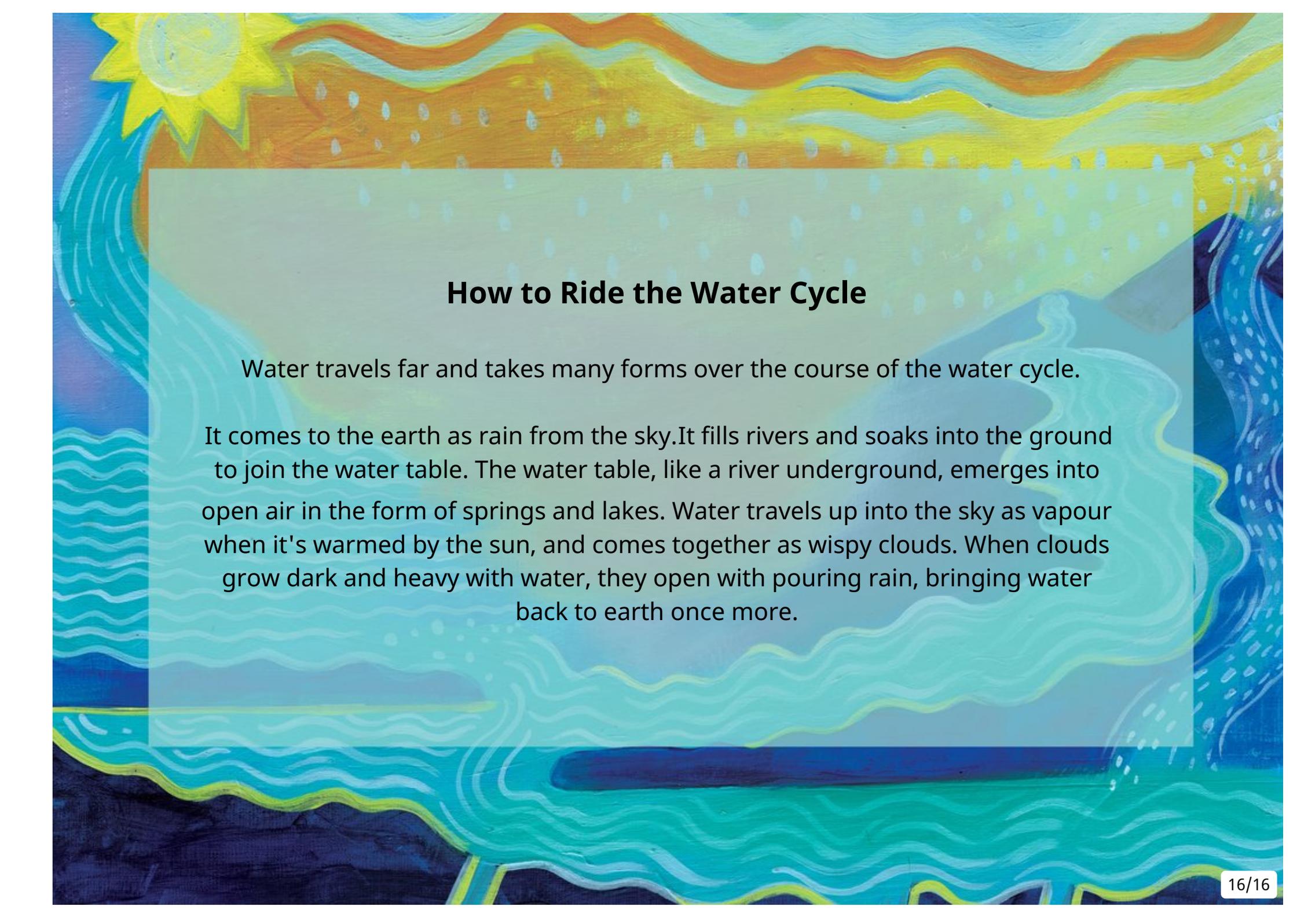
Into skies, far above,

The water table, like a river underground, emerges into open air in the form of springs and lakes. Water travels up into the sky as vapour when it's warmed by the sun, and comes together as wispy clouds. When clouds grow dark and heavy with water, they open with pouring rain, bringing water back to earth once more.

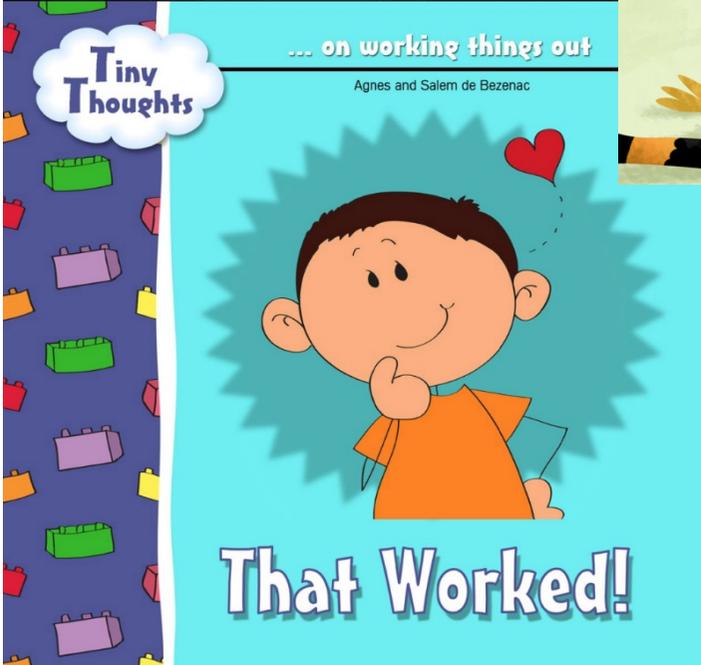
