S'il n'était pas coincé au dessus d'un arbre, je n'aurais pas pris l'échelle pour le sauver.



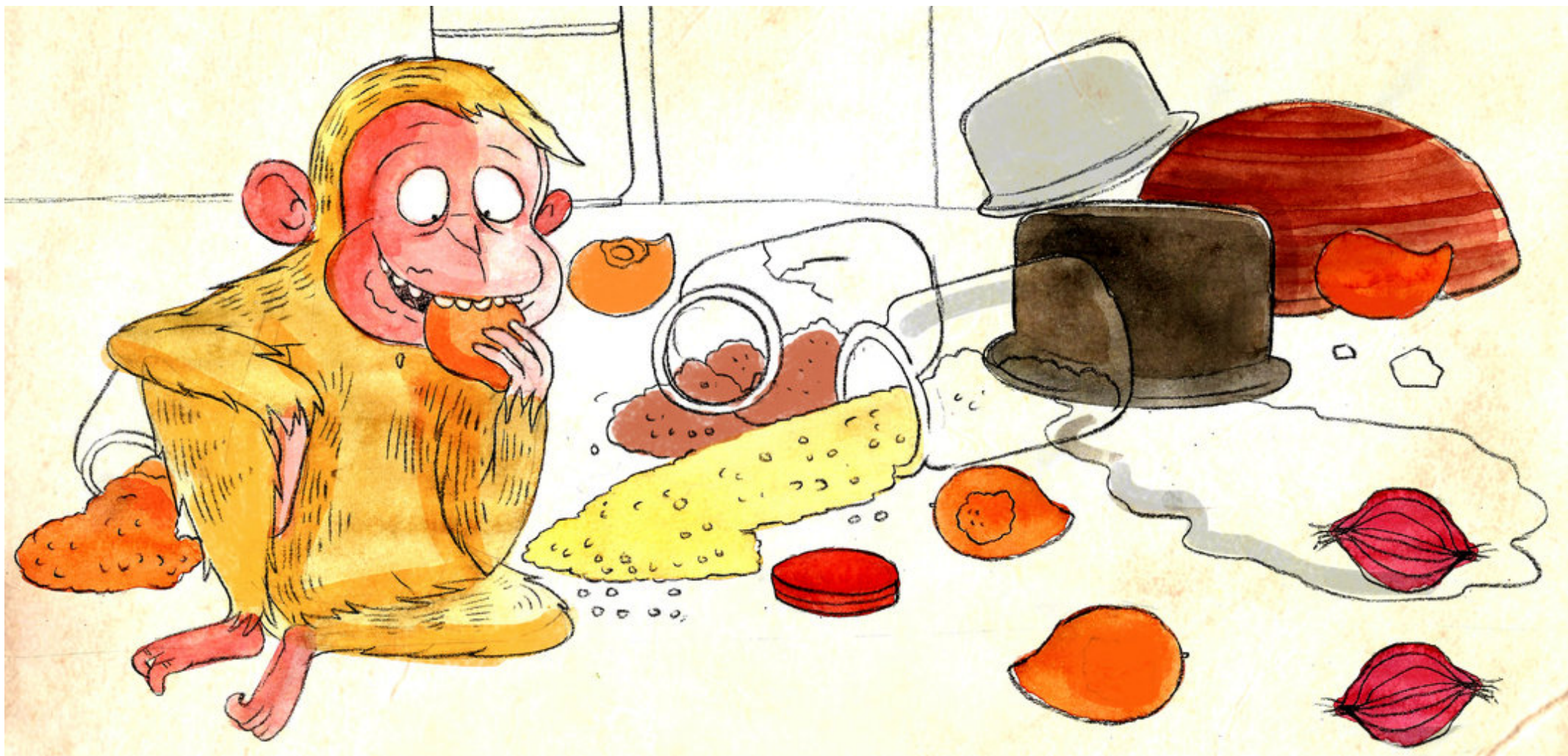

Je n'aurais ni réveillé le bébé par le bruit.



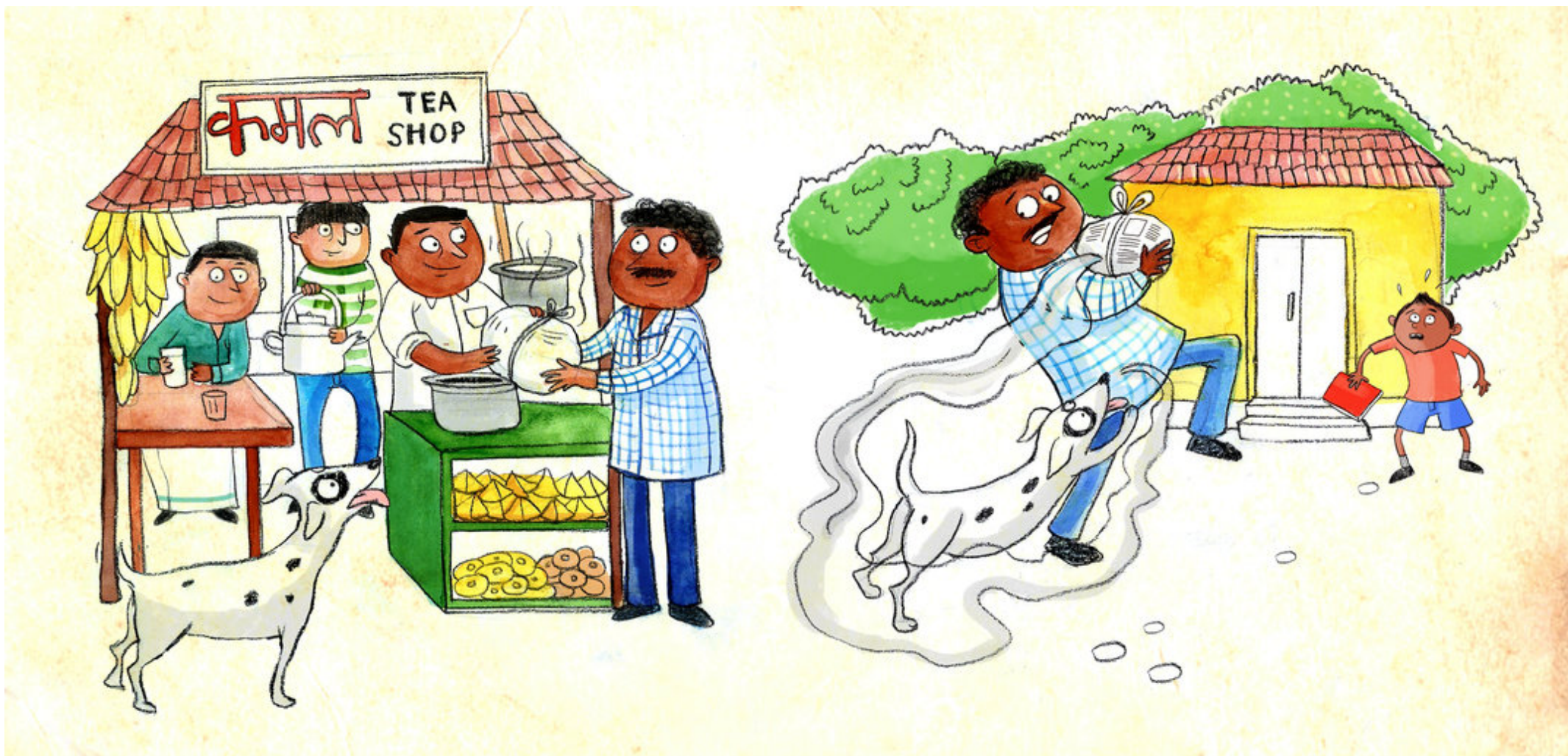
Ma mère n'aurait pas quitté la cuisine.

Un singe y serait ni entré en son absence.

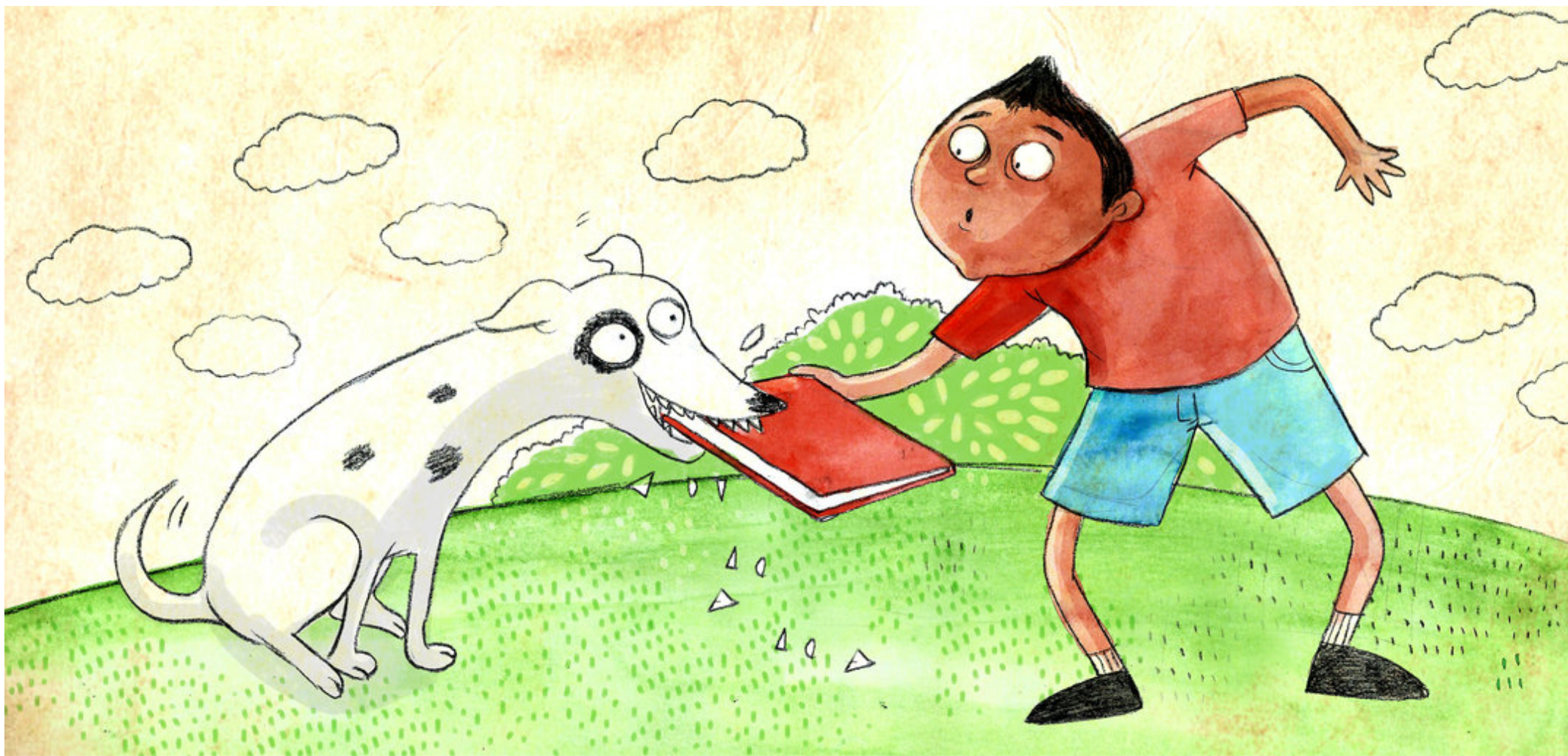


Le singe n'aurait pas mangé toute la nourriture.
