Si no se hubiera quedado atrapada en el árbol, no habría tenido que coger la escalera para subirme a él.



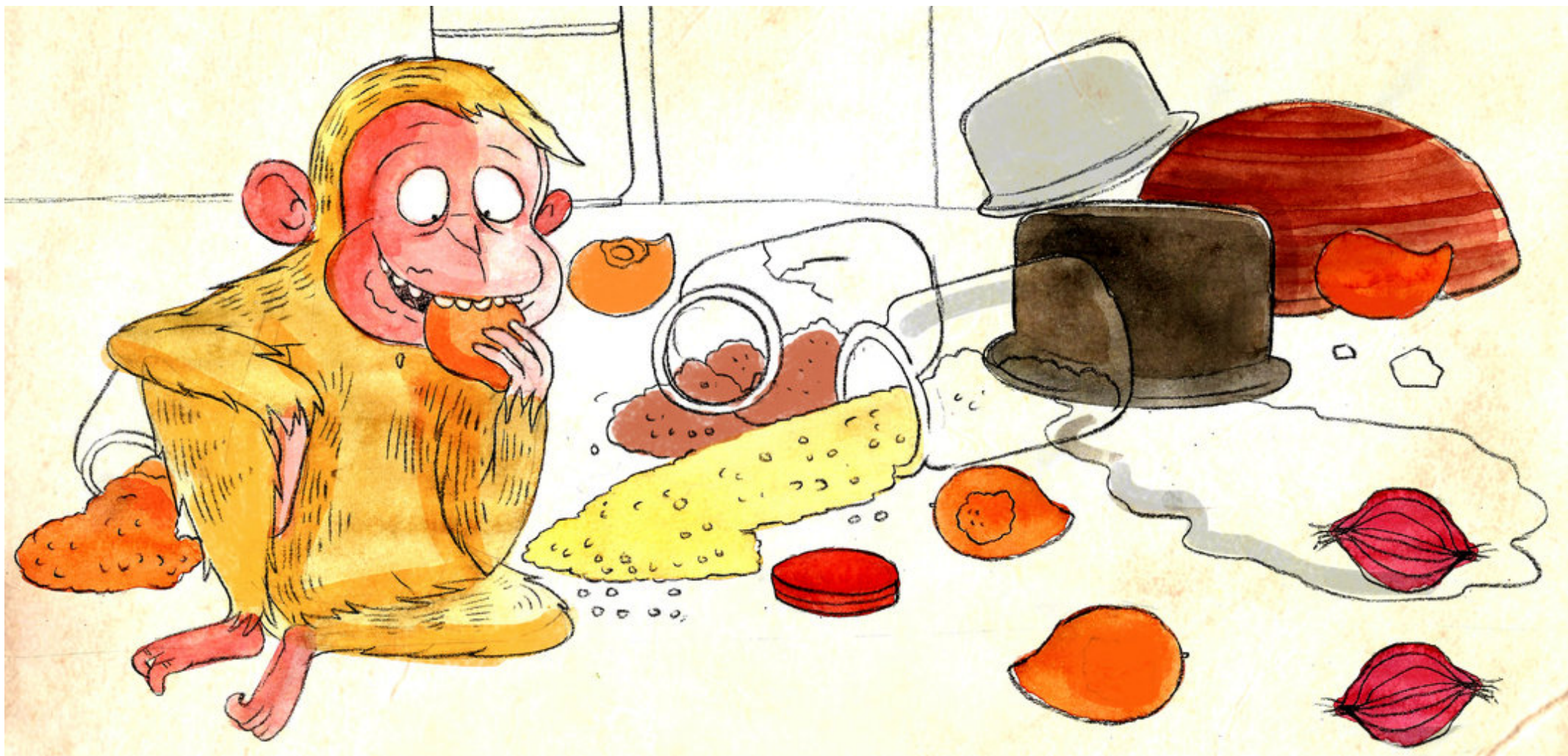
Si no hubiera tenido que coger la escalera para subir, no habría tenido que arreglarla.

Si no hubiera tenido que arreglarla, no habría despertado al bebé.



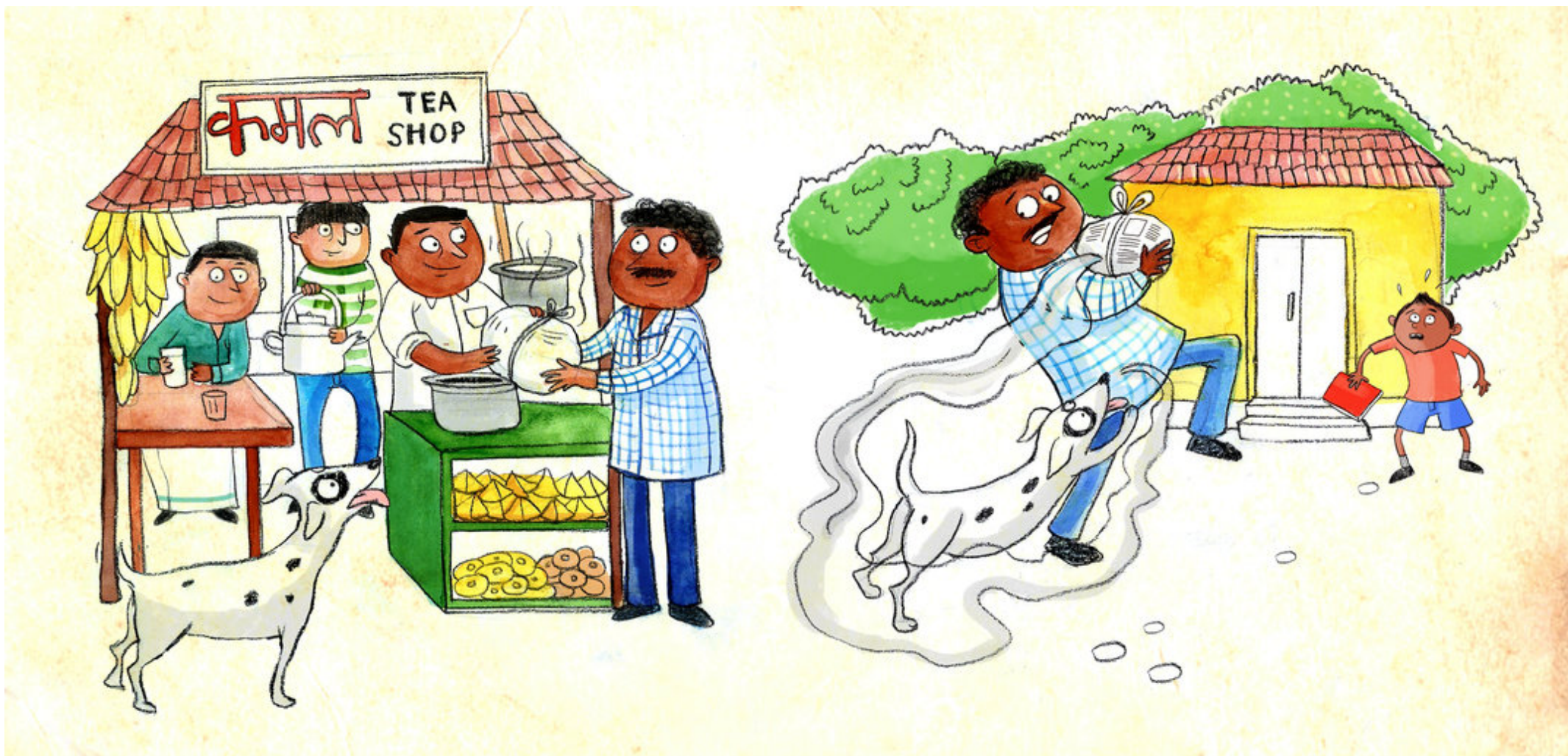
Si no hubiera despertado al bebé, mi madre no habría salido corriendo de la cocina.

Si ni madre no hubiera salido corriendo de la cocina, el mono no habría entrado.

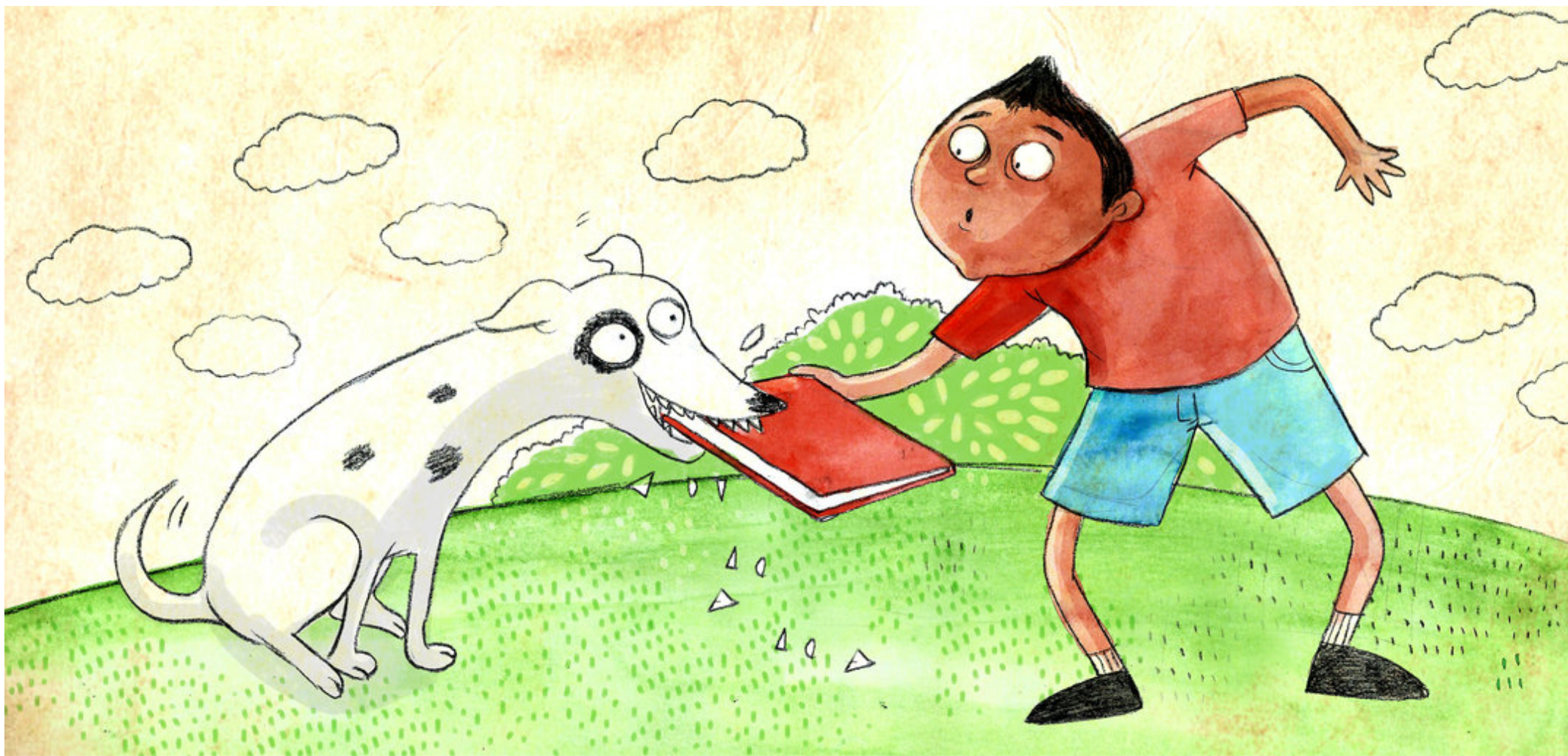


Si el mono no hubiera entrado, no se habría comido todo lo que había.
