

"Hee hee hee! Only if you help me make it, eh?" replied Ammachi.






"Ready?" shouted Sooraj.

"YIPPEE! Our coconut barfi is ready to be eaten!"




Ammachi's barfi was made using **SIMPLE MACHINES!** Simple machines make it easier to do work. There are six kinds of simple machines:

3. Wheel and Axle










4. Wedge
