








Through the minibus window,

big cars and small cars.
























In a big store, we fill a trolley with food.

Bags of flour and bottles of juice.




Mama shows me the toys and asks me to choose! There are soft toys and round toys, loud toys and fast toys.

A pair of shoes and even some treats.


