Ghum-Ghum regarda partout autour d'elle.


« Papa? »

— Savez-vous où est ma famille, Mademoiselle Dauphin?


— Non, mais je sais où se trouvent les meilleurs poissons, indiqua Mademoiselle Dauphin. Tu veux en manger?

— Je suis partie à l'aventure, répondit Ghum-Ghum en pouffant de rire. Et je repars demain!




