




जादूई चिट्ठी





एजाज़ कागज़ को रोशनी में लेकर जाता है।




उसे मोड़ता है और उसमें से देखता है।









लेकिन वहाँ कुछ नहीं मिलता।

एजाज़ दुखी हो जाता है। उसे पता था कि कोई और संकेत उसका इंतजार कर रहा होगा।








रहस्य
