— C'est aussi un visage qui sourit, dit-elle en riant.


— Bravo, je vois que tu as compris le principe de mon jeu, répond Ajji en applaudissant.

Activité : Que peux-tu dessiner avec trois cercles ?




Aji dessine une autre forme.

— Regarde ce que j'ai fait !







— Bravo, Jeenu, la félicite Ajji. Regarde qui vient jouer avec nous !

- C'est un carré ! Euh... regarde Ajji, j'ai dessiné une fenêtre.






— Tu veux que j'ajoute un arbre devant ta fenêtre ? demande Ajji.

— Oh, oui Ajji, merci ! répond Jeenu.


Jeeny observe les dessins à la craie. Peut-elle les peindre maintenant ?
