



"¿Que haré? ¡No hay más libros para leer!" llora Puchku.








Pero hay un problema. Puchku es demasiado corta y la estantería es demasiado larga.


¿Cómo puede coger los libros?

"Voy a tomar éste, éste y éste también," dice Pachku, contenta.


"Tome éste también," sugirió la bibliotecaria muy alta. "Cuando era pequeña, me encantaba este libro."
