

Goat, Dog and Cow were great friends.


One day they went on a journey in a taxi.

Cow paid her fare.




Dog paid extra, because he did not have the correct money.




The driver was about to give Dog his change.

Suddenly Goat ran away without paying.




The driver was very annoyed.

He drove away without giving Dog his change.




That is why, even today, Dog runs towards a car to peep inside.


