One of the Princess' tears fell to the ground below. Just as the tear fell on the ground a fairy appeared in front of her and promised to help.




The saddened princess asked the fairy, "Tell me, how can I make my people and my kingdom healthy and happy again?"




factories, and litter all around and this caused climate change". The fairy explained that the climate change caused the snow to melt and the dangerous, extreme weather.

TIPS FOR PREVENTING CLIMATE CHANGE

Just like the people in this story, if you and I don't look after our environment we will also begin to suffer consequences. Climate change can cause loss of polar ice caps, floods, severe weather, and more.

Here's some things you can do for climate change and to protect the environment -

- Plant native trees and collect rain water for watering;
- Use clean fuel sources such as an electric vehicle, and reduce your fuel footprint - walk or bike or use public transport instead of your carbon fueled car, don't select one day shipping - delivery trucks take more trips that way;
- Use clean energy such as solar or wind when available;
- Use paper bags and glass bottles instead of plastic, bring your own cup instead of using disposable ones, when you do need to use plastic try to use recyclable plastic;
- Use recycling options to dispose of waste wherever available;
- Don't waste electricity or water, use energy efficient light bulbs, use a half flush in your toilet, wash clothes in cold water whenever possible and always do a full load, ensure to switch off appliances and lights not in use; and...
