HALLOWEEN FOOD SUGGESTIONS

Spiderweb pizza

- use mini round margarita pizzas and cut feta into thin strips to make the webs

Oreo beetles

Meringue ghosts

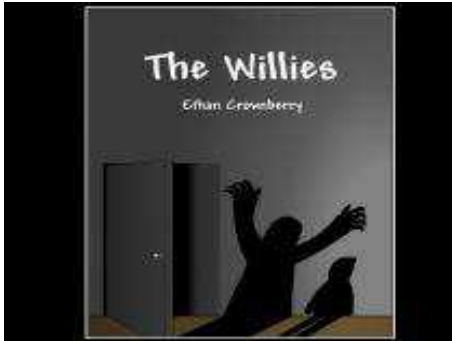
- shape merangues into ghosts and use icing for eyes and mouth

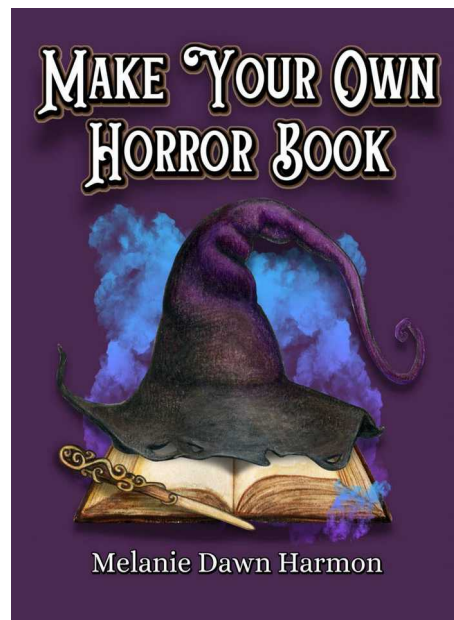
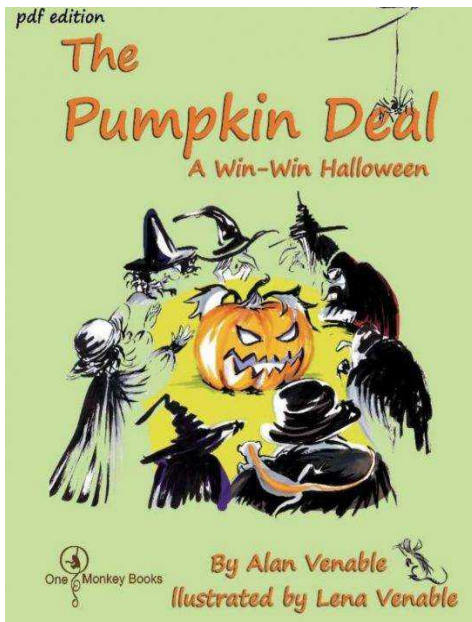
