






One day there was a friendly sharky. He loved meeting people and greeting people.




But he had a lot of pain.

Since everyone he met would run away. He just wanted to be friends but he found himself very lonely.




Then one day he met a seal. The seal didn't run away like everyone else. He asked the seal, why don't you run away like everyone else?




The seal replied, I can see you have a good heart, and you don't want to eat me.


You are a friendly shark.




Why no! Of course I don't want to eat you, I'm a vegetarian. Replied the shark. See - smiled the seal, I am a good judge of character.




But how do I convince the other fish that I am a friendly shark, asked the shark.



Let me take you to my friends. I will introduce you to them and tell them you are a good shark. They will tell their friends, and soon you will not be feared anymore.




So the shark and the seal went to their friends, the sea horse, the penguin, and the octopus. They told them not to be afraid of the shark.
