



"Old Hannah, Old Hannah, let my goat in, please! Your barn is so warm and out here, she will freeze."




It was a small barn for Old Hannah, and the horse, but just enough room for three.

"Old Hannah, Old Hannah, let my dog in, please! Your barn is so warm and out here, he will freeze."




It was a small barn for Old Hannah, the horse, and the goat, but just enough room for four. The boy brought him in and said, "Do not bark."
