Dragonfly is sad because he wants to join, but he lost his violin.




"I have an idea!" says Butterfly.




Butterfly and Dragonfly fly to Ladybird's house.

Then, Butterfly begins to look for a cobweb.


"What are doing now?" whines Dragonfly.
