
Question: How many classical composers can you name? We usually think of classical composers as European or Western, but there's lots of Eastern music that can be termed 'classical' as well.




Three Herons




When a little lamb is born A fairy shepherd blows his horn!






Lamp in hand, he searched high and low. Did he find one? Sorry. No.


