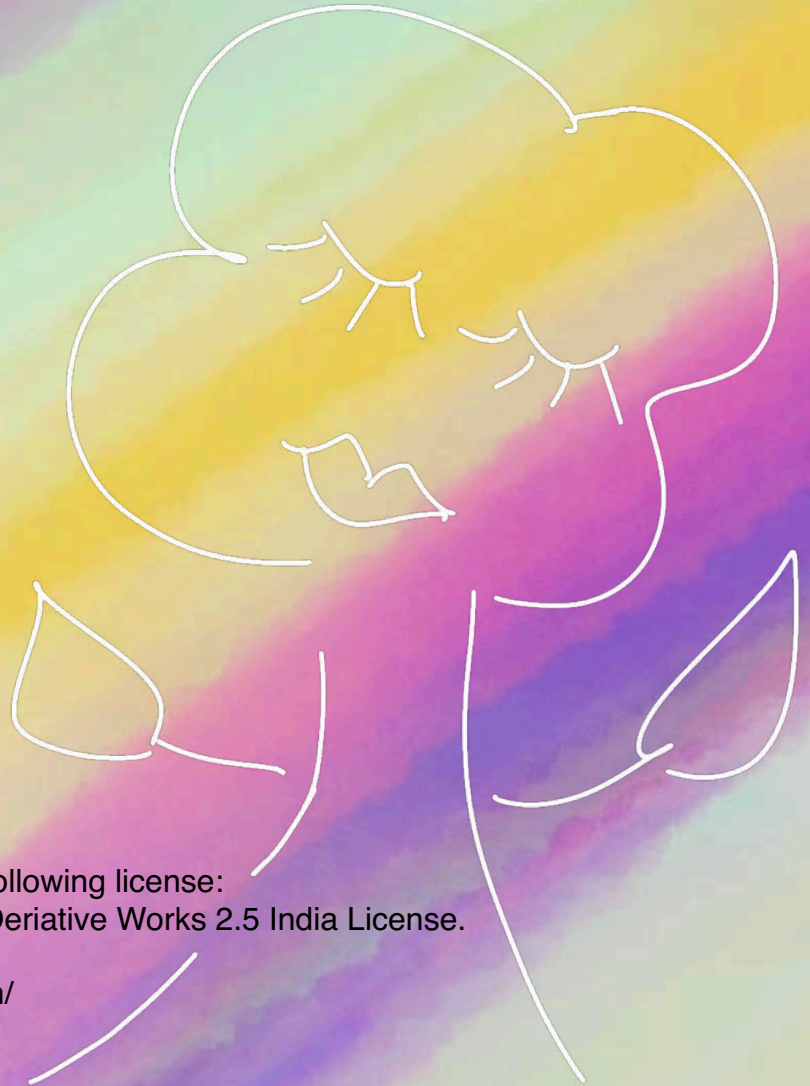

completely !

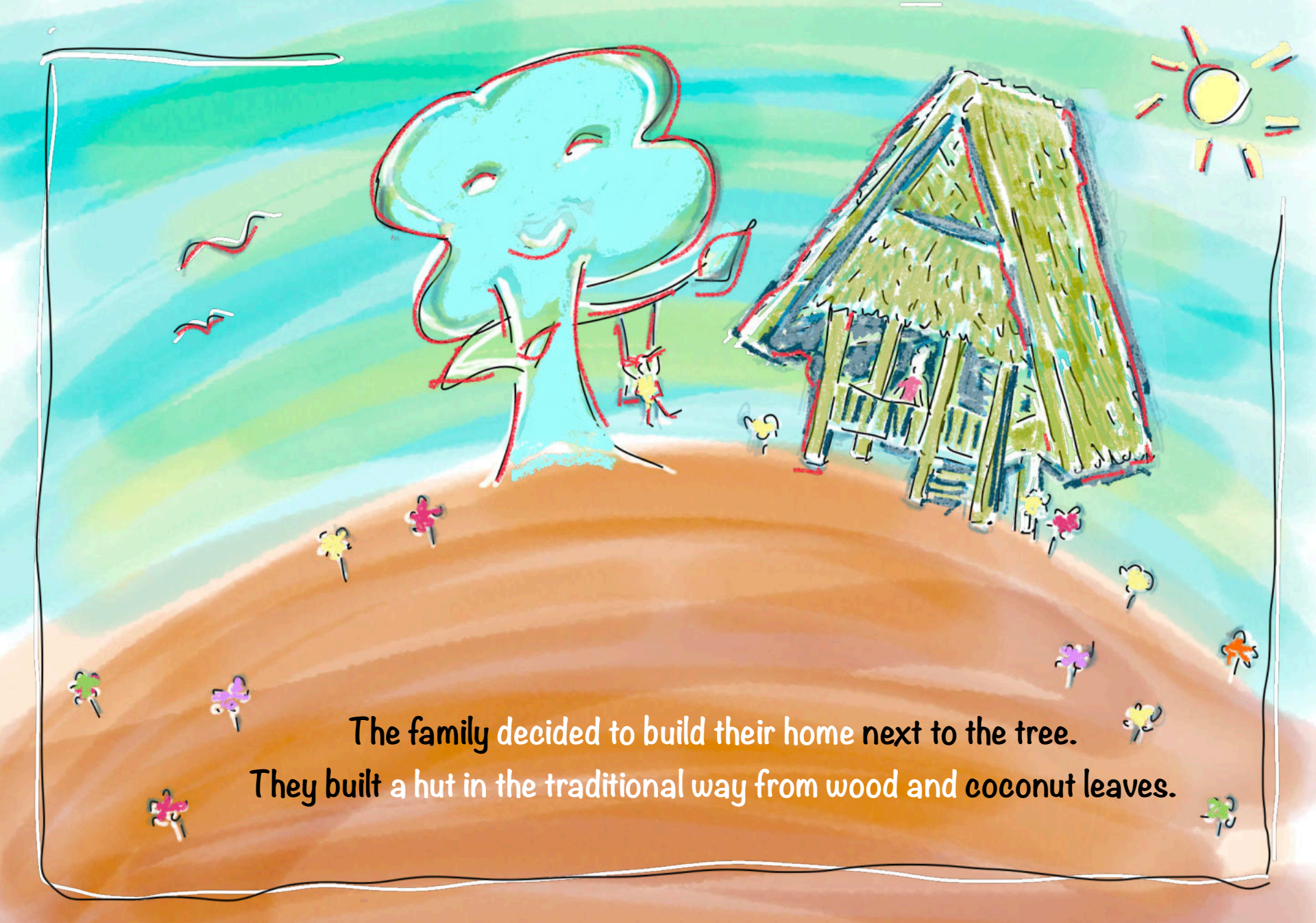


One beautiful morning...

It means that our planet is suffering and so do we!”





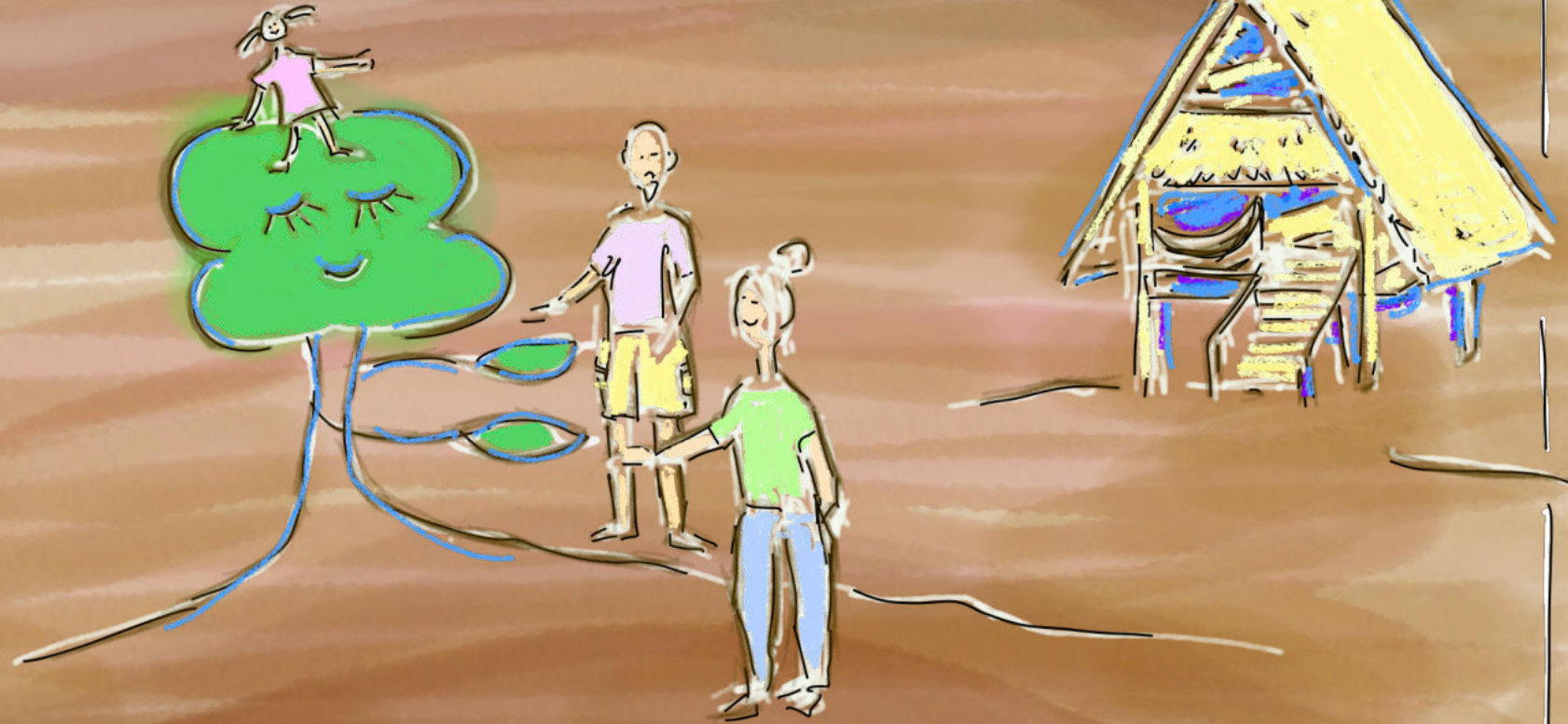
“Many years had passed. Slowly, slowly I managed to grow one branch and another branch, new leaves, flowers, fruits...Until I became a mature tree.”

and joined the lonely tree.

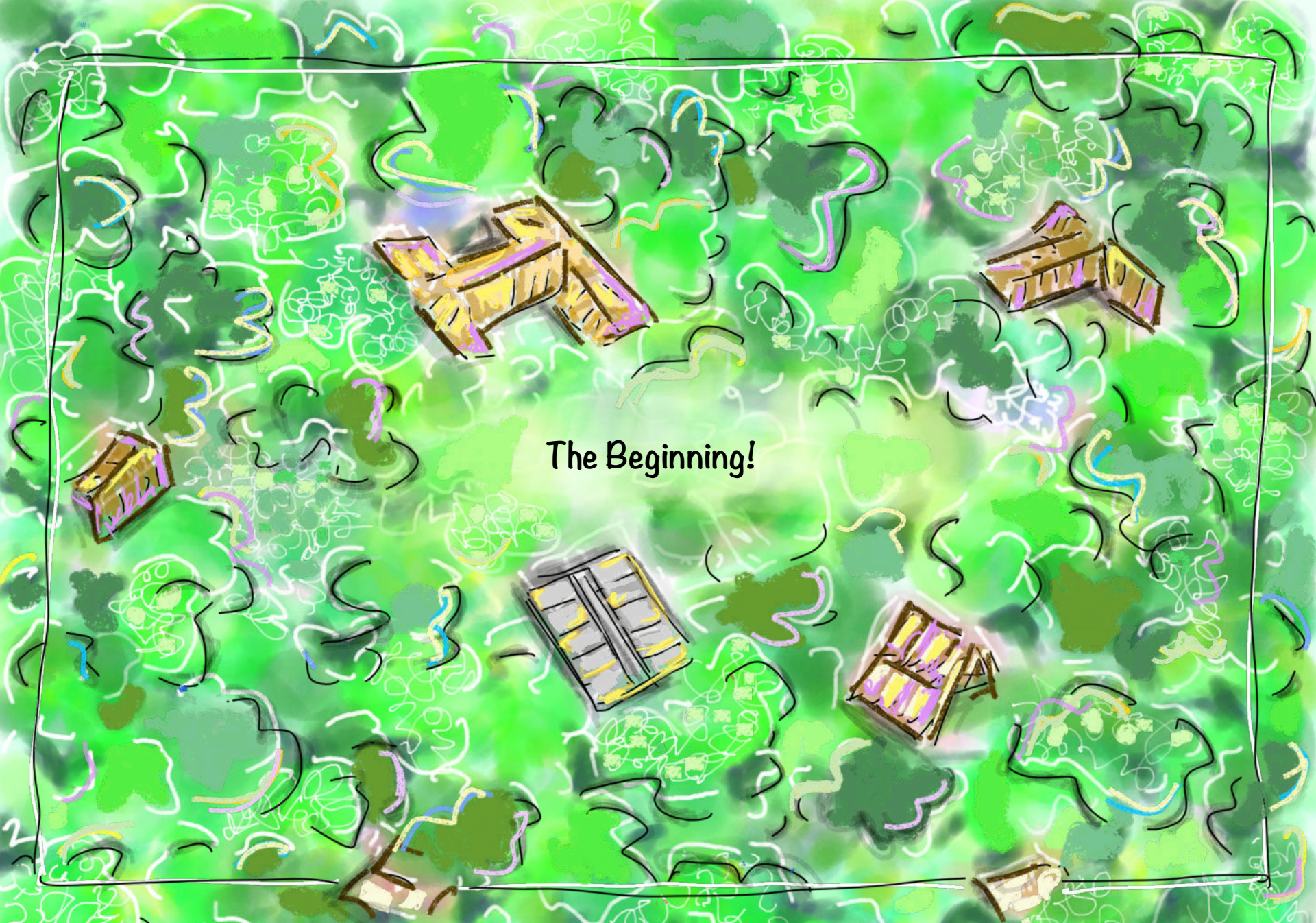




The tree was so happy. Many birds came to visit him day and night.
